**Data Protection:** When participating in a competition, the following data may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors: for instance, target lists and results lists may be published. This data includes first name, gender, bow style, date of birth/age category, email address, home address, phone number, club (and ID), county (and ID), region (and ID), round (unless defined by age), disability status (Y/N), and disability information.

**Special Requirements:** If you require any special arrangements due to disability or other reasons, please notify the organisers at the time of entry.

**Photography:** If you wish to take photographs, please register with the organiser in advance.

## Details

- Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>, medals for 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place for the longest distance, medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, for Albion and Windsor
- A minimum of two competitors is required in any category for medals to be awarded.
- Participants may request to shoot out of category. For example, if a category has only one female recurve archer and four male recurve archers, the female archer may choose to shoot in the open category to remain eligible for medals.
- Arrows will be collected only when instructed by the judge.
- A “worst white” will be called at the longest distance, at time chosen by the judge.
- Facilities are available courtesy of the Sportsman Bar, including refreshments and toilets.

Rounds will follow Method 1

- One sound signal shall indicate when the first shooting detail shall take their place on the line and begin shooting. Each archer shall shoot six arrows and immediately retire, being replaced by the archer from the subsequent detail.
- When all archers have shot, three sound signals shall indicate that archers are to move forward to score and collect arrows. No archer shall advance from the shooting line before receiving the signal.
- Archers are free to decide whether to rotate detail after each end.
