



IGSA Coaches Selection Criteria Process Document

These are a list of some, but not necessarily all, of the criteria that are used to select coaches for each of the IGSA seasons of play. All Head Coaching positions are at the discretion of the ExBod and a coach may have the privilege revoked if the ExBod deems it necessary.

1. Fall and Spring Rec Coach Criteria

- a. No disciplinary actions against
- b. Child is registered for the season
- c. Date of request
- d. Attends all meetings
- e. Coaches multiple seasons
- f. Good communication
- g. Organized at practices and games
- h. Wants to learn/asks for help
- i. Good game knowledge
- j. Team responds positively
- k. Understand and Implements the IGSA Way
- l. Understands the difference in coaching girls
- m. No unaddressed negative feedback resulting from seasonal coach evaluations

2. Fall Select, Spring Select, and All-Star Coach Criteria

- a. No disciplinary actions against
- b. Child is registered for the season and has been evaluated as a Select / All Star level player
- c. Date of Request
- d. Attended all meetings
- e. Excellent communication
- f. Knowledge of players within division
- g. Organized at practices and games
- h. Understands the importance of equitable playing time during friendlies
- i. Understands the importance of winning-first priority during tournaments
- j. Above average game knowledge
- k. Motivates team
- l. Develops both individual skills and situational awareness
- m. Understand and Implements the IGSA Way
- n. Understands the difference in coaching girls
- o. No unaddressed negative feedback resulting from seasonal coach evaluations
- p. Encourages supplemental/independent skills coaching and training
