At the Procession with Palms—Gospel

- Hosanna means “Save now!” What areas of your life do you need to experience Jesus as Savior.

1st Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7

- What word or phrase spoke to you? Why?
- Who are the “weary” in need of the Lord today in our community?

Psalm 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24

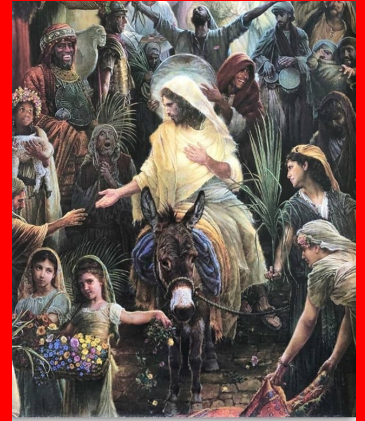
- Where/When have you experienced mockery for your faith in Christ?
- How does this psalm help you relate to Jesus’ suffering?

2nd Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

- What does it mean to call Jesus “Lord” rather than just “Savior?”
- Where is the Lord asking you to be more obedient or offer sacrificial love?

Gospel: Matthew 26:14—27:66

- What are the “thirty pieces of silver” in your life that compromise faith in Jesus?
- How does understanding Jesus as the Lamb of God change our appreciation for the Mass and Holy Communion?
- In facing unjust accusation, what does Jesus’ silence teach us about unfair criticism or suffering in your life?
- How does reflecting on the physical and emotional suffering of Jesus increase our love for Him?
- Where is Jesus calling you to deeper trust or repentance as you enter into the story of the Passion?
