Like most people in this village, Lakshmi followed the cultural religion. She prayed to many gods. She had idols all throughout her home. She performed rituals and presented offerings to different ones each day. Despite all of her efforts and allegiance to these gods, she had no peace.

Her husband suffered addiction. Lakshmi suffered too. All of their money was used to buy alcohol, and his drinking made living with him difficult. When he died, Lakshmi lost everything. His death meant their family went from not having enough money to having nothing at all.

This is when some of Lakshmi's neighbors invited her to church.

Bishop Amos and his team serve the churches throughout his county in Kenya. His churches that once had only a few members each now have many.


What changed?

"People are changed. One family has become a church of 60 people! Drunks and addicts are being changed. In the prison, many are changed and some have even been discharged," he says.

Many of the people in Amos' community cannot read—his family included. According to Amos, they've never shown an interest in church. But even they are listening to God's Word on a Talking Bible.

Pastors who did not have a Bible now have a Talking Bible. Non-readers can finally hear God's Word. The elderly are happily listening to Scripture and sharing what they hear with others. Motorbike riders are starting Bible listening groups. Young people are joining the church.

When people encounter the Living Word of God, they cannot be the same as they were before. God is using the Talking Bible to speak to the hearts and minds of the people in Kakamega. He is speaking to them in the language that they know and love.

"The audio Scripture can be shared anywhere and at any time," says Bishop Amos. "When you share it, the people will not forget you. They will invite you to come again."
