Greeters (Eucharistic Minister). Please check in 20 minutes prior to Mass. Eucharistic Ministers proceed to your assigned positions to greet parishioners/visitors. P1, P2 & P3 – Narthex, P4 – Side Door Holy Family Side, P5 – Side Door Tabernacle Side.

Eucharistic Ministers and Readers Dress Code: When ministering to others, Liturgical Ministers are the face of Christ for the assembly. The image we project reflects not only the dignity of the ministerial role, but our own dignity as well. Dress should express respect and reverence for the sacred mysteries that are being celebrated. It should not draw attention. All Liturgical Ministers should wear professional (no less than business casual) and modest attire.

As you approach the altar during the Lamb of God, sanitize hands, receive Communion, sanitize once again, return to Altar and the presider for that Mass will bring the Ciboria to you – you do not need to enter the sanctuary (unless it's Fr. Kraig or Fr. Sheil). Sanitize after distribution
