Trust in his Power; Fear his Destructions; Desire His Deliverance (3-10)

- Delivers from Enemies (imprecatory prayer) (3-6)
 - Defeat them (3a)
 - Your presence alone is enough to destroy the enemy (3b)
 - You defend your own in justice and righteousness (4)
 - Better make sure you're on God's side, because He doesn't "respect persons"
 - God's rebuke wipes out the heathen (5)
- God's work is different (6)
 - Permanent work (contrast to vs. 6) (7a)
 - Diligent work (7b-8)
 - o God protects (9)
 - Judge (7-8)
 - Refuge (9)
 - Faithful (10)
- How does this tie into the "Why do the heathen rage" and "kiss ye the son" in Psalm 2?
- Why is this both a comfort and a warning to us?
