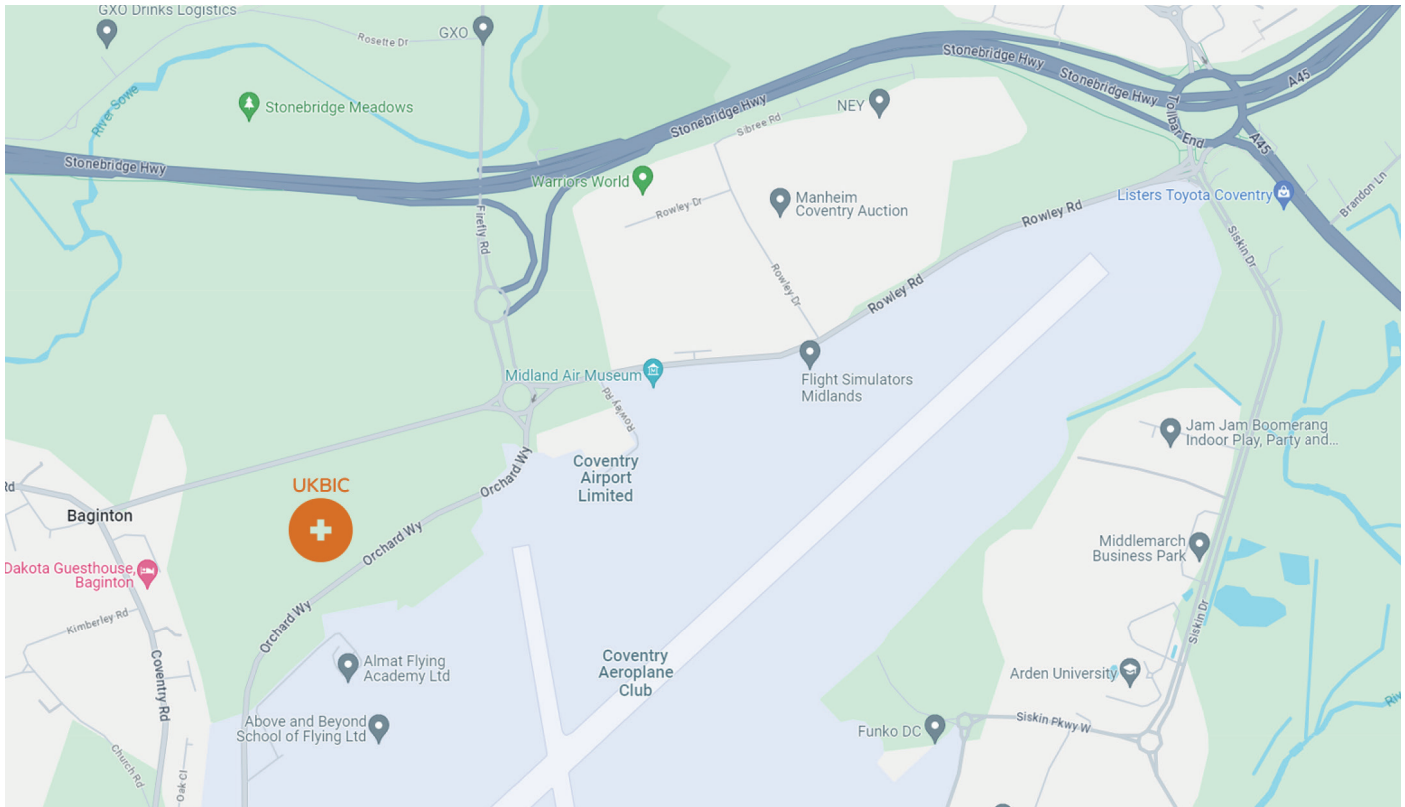


# Visiting UKBIC

## Getting here

### By car

UKBIC is located near Baginton Village on Rowley Road, adjacent to the northern boundary of Coventry Airport, south of the A45. Once on the road between the A45 roundabout and Baginton village you can't miss us!

### By train

The nearest train station is Coventry, which is a 10 minute car journey from UKBIC. Taxis and ride-hailing services are readily available outside the train station: Station Square, Coventry CV1 2GT

### By air

Birmingham International Airport is less than a 30 minute drive away, or a short train journey to Coventry railway station.

# Visiting UKBIC

## When you arrive

### Parking

Subject to availability, there are on site accessible spaces and electric vehicle charging spaces. Drive up to the barrier and press the buzzer to speak to Reception and tell them who you are there to see. When parked, please follow the signs to Reception.

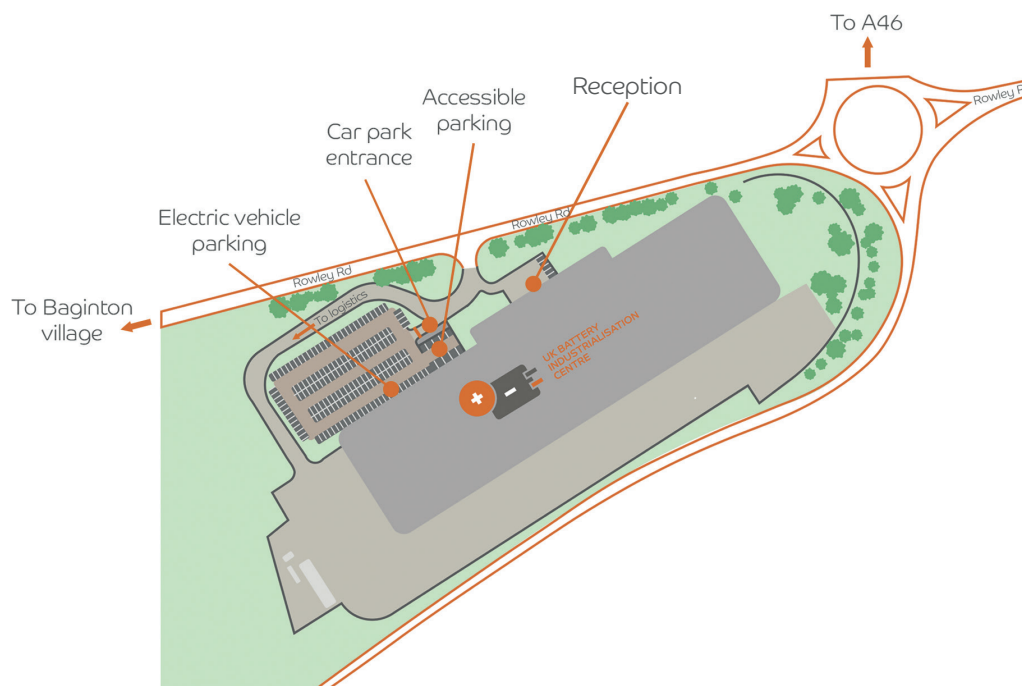
### Arrival

Your contact at UKBIC will pre-register you with Reception. You will receive a temporary pass giving you access to relevant areas of the facility. You will need to return this pass and sign out when you leave. For large groups of 10 or more visiting the facility, please follow the guidance provided by your visit co-ordinator.

All visitors must present original photographic identification upon arrival at UKBIC. Acceptable forms of ID include:

- Passport
- UK or international driving licence
- Student ID card

Please note that photocopies or scanned versions of ID will not be accepted.



## Welfare

There is a café next to Reception which serves hot and cold food and drinks between 8am and 2pm Monday to Thursday, and between 8am and 11am on Fridays. A fresh coffee machine is available to buy drinks outside of these hours.

Accessible toilets are also available across the site.

Your host should advise you on our on-site health and safety practices and any planned fire alarms.

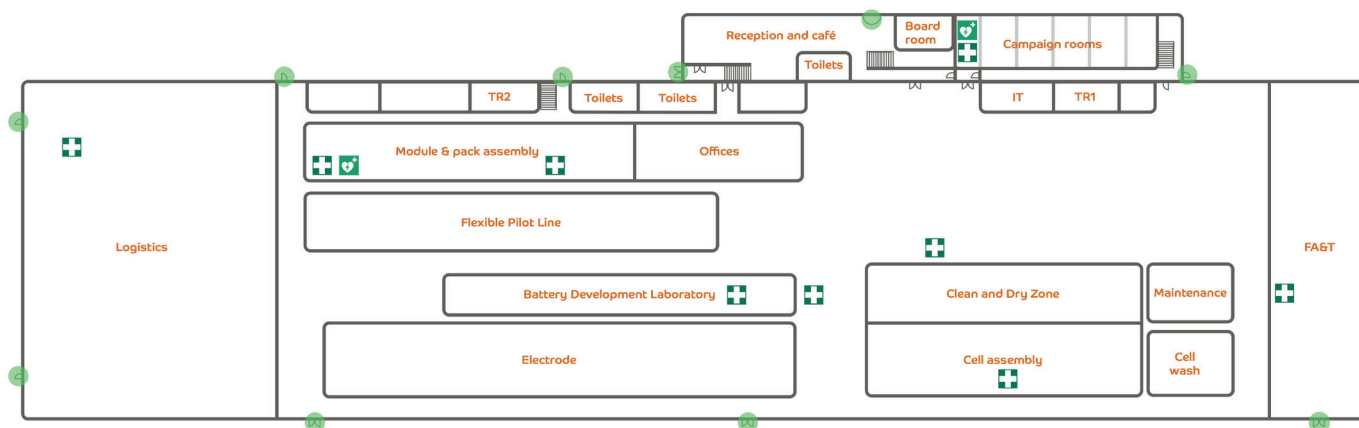
### Fire safety
