## MO ABLE Accounts Available

Missouri Achieving a Better Life Experience Accounts (MO ABLE) allow individuals with disabilities to save and invest money without losing eligibility for benefits such as SSI or Medicaid, while promoting greater financial independence and long-term stability.

Missouri residents whose disability began before age 26 may open an account, either independently or through an authorized representative.

Funds can be used tax-free for qualified disability expenses including healthcare, housing, education, transportation, employment supports, assistive technology, and personal services.

Balances under \$100,000 do not affect SSI, and MO ABLE funds do not impact Medicaid or other federally means-tested benefits.

The State of Missouri also offers state income tax deductions of up to \$8,000 (single) or \$16,000 (married) per year.
