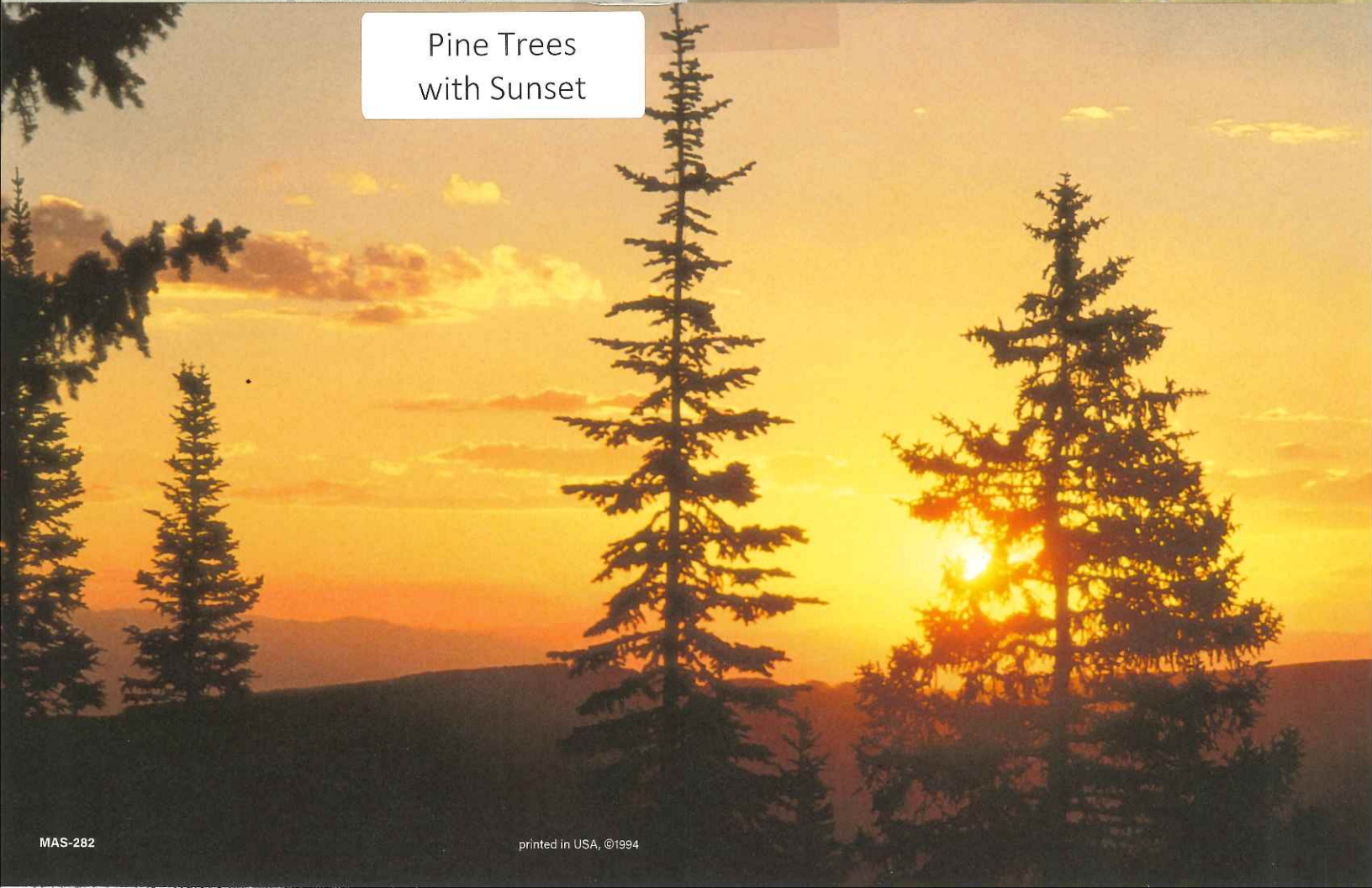

## In Loving Memory

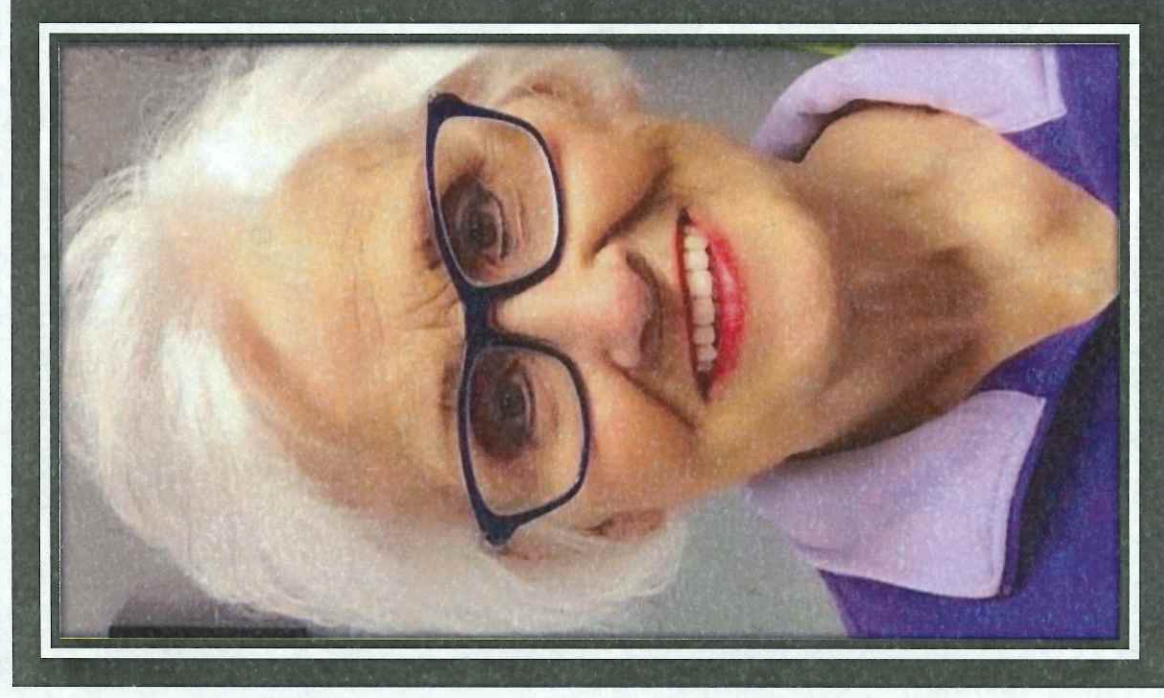
