

WHO MIGHT BE INTERESTED IN TAKING THIS COURSE?

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification, candidates may not have any prior knowledge or experience, however an interest in the subject area is preferable.

WHAT WILL THE CANDIDATE STUDY AS PART OF THIS QUALIFICATION?

The content of this award has been designed to give the candidates the knowledge required to work or operate safely around Hybrid Electric Vehicles. It contains one mandatory unit covering:

- The types of Hybrid Electric Vehicles.
- Hazards associated with motor vehicle high voltage electrical systems.
- Working safely around Hybrid Electric Vehicles, including charging systems.

As a result, candidates successfully completing this qualification will acquire core knowledge of working safely around, but not maintaining Hybrid Electric Vehicles.

ASSESSMENT:

This knowledge qualification is tested via an IMI online test, EV1 (15 questions – 60% pass mark).

WHICH SUBJECTS WILL COMPLIMENT THIS COURSE?

This qualification will help support progression onto qualifications that further develop their knowledge of either working safely in emergency or recovery situations, or within a technical role carrying out routine servicing and maintenance activities on Hybrid Electric Vehicles.

- IMI - Level 2 Award in Hybrid Electric Vehicle Hazard Management for Emergency and Recovery Personnel.
- IMI - Level 2 Award in Hybrid Electric Vehicle Routine Maintenance Activities.

Further progression:

- IMI – Level 3 Award in Hybrid Electric Vehicle System Repair and Replacement.
- IMI – Level 4 Award in the Diagnosis Testing and Repair of Electric Hybrid Vehicles and Components.
