#### **School Pick-Up & Supervision Information**

Player 1 Music School provides a free, supervised pick-up service from North Perth Primary School for students enrolled in our Tuesday and Wednesday group programs.

A Player 1 staff member will collect students from the school and walk them safely to Player 1 Music School for their lesson.

#### **Important information for parents:**

- Parents must advise North Perth Primary School that their child will be collected by Player 1 Music School staff
- Pre-Primary students will be collected directly from their classrooms
- Year 1 students will be collected from their classrooms for the first two weeks of the program
- From Week 3 onwards, and for all other year levels, students must meet Player 1 staff outside the Year 1 & 2 classrooms at the rear of the school, near the half gate
- If your child is absent from school or not attending their music session, please notify us via the Customer Portal or by texting 0450 752 462
- Parents must collect their child from Player 1 Music School at the end of the session (3:45pm or 4:15pm, depending on enrolment)
