MISSIONS

The building project has officially begun, with the foundation completed and plans for plumbing and slab work underway in June. July will focus on gathering materials for construction. 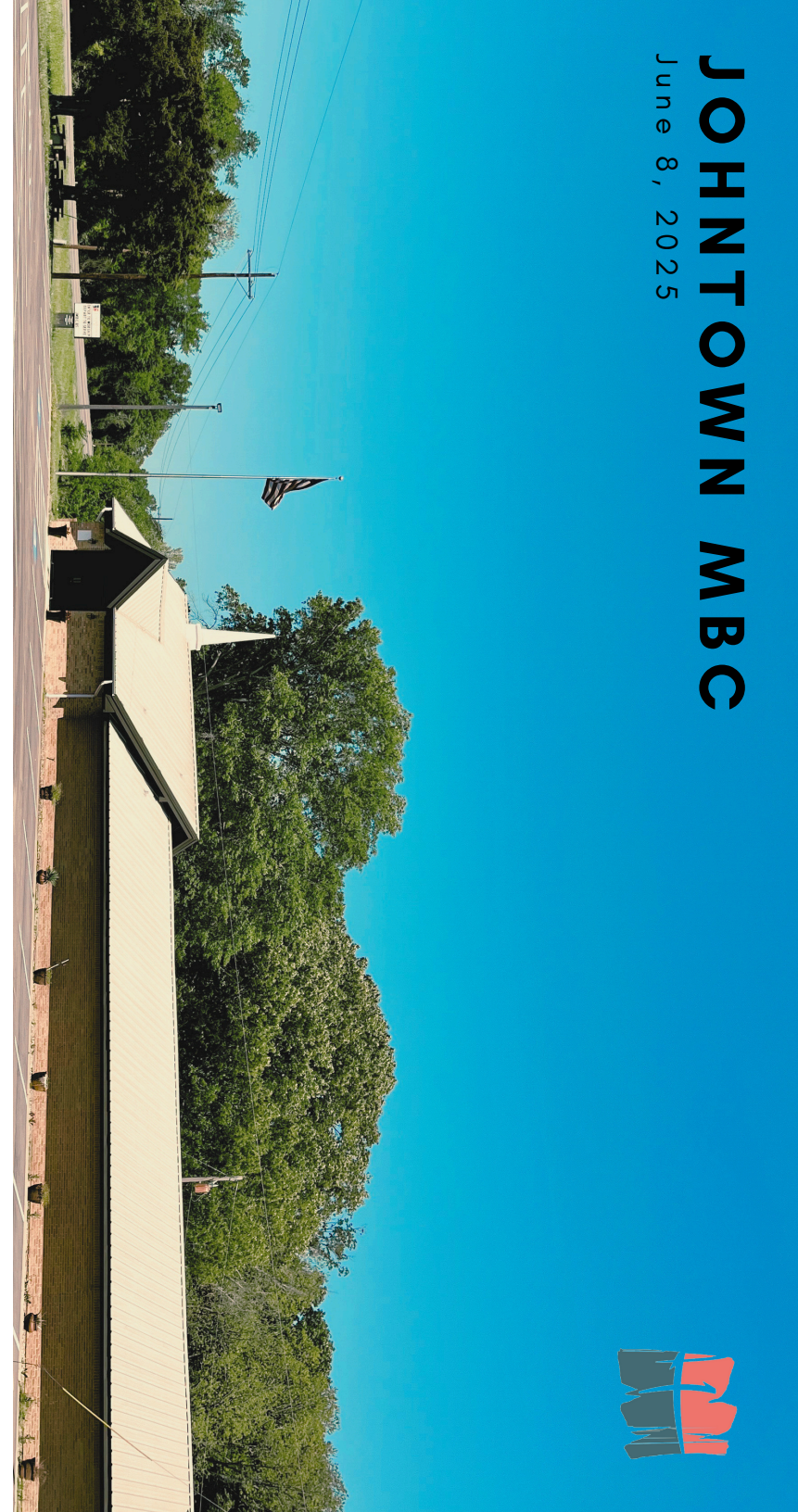
ABOUT ME...

My name is Bradley Taylor. I have lived in Henderson, Texas, for about twenty-two of the thirty years I have been alive. For those years, I have been a member of Calvary Baptist Church. My parents moved my sister and me to Conroe, Texas, where we lived for about six years before returning to Henderson. During our time in Conroe, we were members of West Conroe Baptist Church, and a group came in to help our church put on a production of Heaven Gates and Hell Flames, and they chose my dad to play the devil. In his performance, he could be seen dragging young children from their families because they had not trusted in Jesus Christ as their Savior. His acting was so good that I was scared straight, so to speak. That night I told my dad that I needed to get right, and that night made a profession of faith. I was about 8.

When I was in the fourth grade, my family and I moved back to Henderson. I entered high school some years later and was very involved in the youth group at Calvary. In the tenth grade, I surrendered to the ministry but immediately fell away from Christ. In 2016, I met a girl named Susan and was very quickly head over heels for her. During this time, I had been feeling God tug at my heart, wanting to come back to him. We finally decided to start attending Calvary services as a family, and that is when everything changed. We began getting involved with many ministries, and after a short time, God started bringing to remembrance the fact that I had surrendered my life to Him in the past.
