

2021 California State Games Track & Field Athlete Parade and Torch Ceremony



Saturday, July 17, 2021, 7:30am (7:45 start)

University City High School Stadium, 6949 Genesee Ave, San Diego, CA 92122

STAGING AREA: Athletes, unattached and team members with their coaches, should line up at the North end of the track at 7:30am on Saturday morning. Please allow time to park, find seats and then get to athlete staging area by 7:30am. The STAGING AREA is shown below in YELLOW.

ATHLETE PARADE: The Athlete Parade will start in the Staging area and go along the track to the South end and then enter the field. This is shown below in GREEN. Athletes and coaches will stay on the field for the Torch Ceremony. Coaches please keep your athletes under control and together on the field.

TORCH CEREMONY: The Athletes participating in the Parade will stay on the field shown below in BLUE. The Torch will be passed along the RED LINE shown below.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Certain Team Captains will have the opportunity to pass the California State Games Torch. The Team Captains will report to the RED LINE shown below on the West side of field. Once athletes have finished the Parade and are stationed on the field, we will hand the Torch to the first Captain, and then that Captain will pass it to the next Captain. LEAVING THE FIELD: Athletes and coaches should leave the field immediately after the Torch Ceremony and go back into the stands until their event is called. Racewalkers should report directly to the Clerk of the Course.

The Parade and Torch Ceremony should take about 20 minutes.

Coaches please stay with your team and guide them during the Parade and have them stay on the field until after the torch ceremony is over. Please assist with getting everyone off the field in an efficient and timely safe manner, so we can start the meet on time.
