

Year 3 – Connected Curriculum

Spring Term

English

This term, we will be looking at two fiction texts, which is a meeting tale and a character flaw tale. They will also be looking at persuasive writing as our non-unit text.

Towards the end of the term, we will be learning our playscripts as we get ourselves ready for the Easter performance!

History

As our main focus will be Geography this term, we will be briefly finding out about the histories of some European countries and putting the main events onto a timeline.

Science

In science, we will be finishing our topic of rocks, looking at soils. After that, we will be focusing on light (darkness, sunlight, reflection and shadows).

RE

- Diversity within Hindu Dharma: What do Hindus believe and how may they live?
- Why is Jesus such a special person to some religious people? How might this help Christians live a good life?



Europe

Geography

Children will be learning about the different countries that make up the continent of Europe, their features, languages and currencies. We will also be comparing two European capital cities. Children will also be learning about landmarks, rivers and mountains.

Art and Design

For the second term, our focus will be on different cityscapes, with our focussed artist being Stephen Wiltshire. The skills we will be learning are drawing and painting. In DT, we will be looking at designing and creating our own bunting, focusing on cutting and sewing.

Maths

During this term we will be using White Rose Maths, focusing on:

- Multiplication and division,
- Measurement (length and perimeter),
- Fractions
- Measurement (Mass and capacity).

PE – Tag rugby and gymnastics

These activities will help them build coordination, confidence, and teamwork.
