Spring Term

Geography – Natural disasters

In Geography, we will be finding out about natural disasters, mainly earthquakes and volcanoes, and learning how the earth is made up using different layers. We will be having some exciting WOW days where the children will be using creativity and initiative.

English – This term, are two fiction texts will focus on are meeting tales and rags to riches tales. The children will also be learning how to write information text and how to write a persuasive text. Towards the end of the term we will also be learning our playscripts as we will be getting ready for our Easter performance.

RE

Our two 'Big Questions' in RE this term are:

What is a Humanist? What kind of world do Humanist want to live in?

What do Christians learn about the incarnation of Jesus? Do all Christians agree?

Maths (White Rose)

During this term we will focus on:

Multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions, decimals.

RHE (Jigsaw)

Our first theme is 'Dreams and Goals' where we will be learning about ambitions. Our second theme is 'Healthy Me' where we will be finding out how to stay healthy.

Art – A journey into space

Next term, your children will embark on a creative journey as we explore the theme of Space! We will be using mixed media to create fantastic celestial artworks, allowing children to experiment with different materials. They will develop a range of skills and techniques, including the use of marbling for cosmic patterns, chalk for blending and shading, and paint to explore colour and texture.



Wild World

Science – This term, we're diving into an exciting range of scientific areas! Students will be exploring concepts related to Sound, Data Collection, Electricity, and Energy. We'll be conducting simple, hands-on experiments to help solidify their understanding of these key scientific principles.



ICT – Spreadsheets, Espresso coding

We will be learning how to use a variety of spreadsheets and coding using Espresso.
