#### Hi Fashion's Quilters Quarter Inch...

Hi Quilter friends! As we enter a season of short, cloudy days, I find myself gravitating to the sewing room more than ever. Lately, several people have asked how to achieve a better quarter-inch stitch. We discussed some tried-and-true tips: using starch and pressing seams flat (without folds), nesting seams to help points meet up, and pausing at each seam to check alignment. If seams aren't matching, I take advantage of fabric's flexibility to gently nudge them into place. We also talked about

using a scant quarter inch and employing seam guides for extra accuracy. One thing I didn't mention at the time was the importance of needle and thread choice. The thread size can make a real difference—a thicker thread uses up more fabric when pressed open, subtly shrinking your block. My favorite piecing thread lately is Quilter Select 60wt paired with an 80/12 needle. I love a Microtex sharp, but a universal needle works well, too. Sew on and sew forth—wishing you Happy Holidays and Happy Sewing!

# **TECH CORNER**

I bet there are over 100 different choices of needles on the market. What needle should you be using? My suggestion is pick the needle for the fabric you are going to sew on then the correct thread for the project. Using a big thick thread with a skinny needle will not be successful and a thin thread with a huge needle will not work either. Heavy or dense fabric needs a larger needle like a size 14 or 16 and a weight of thread that is a 40wt. Also match the needle tip to your fabric, a stretchy knit needs a stretch or jersey needle and woven quilting cotton I use a Microtex (sharp) size 10 or 12. We have great staff that can help you with your needle dilemma.

Changing the needle is your first trouble shooting option if you have skipping or funny noises or nesting under the fabric. Needles get dull after 8 hours of

use or about 4 full bobbins of sewing. I have a great tool to hold on to the needle when you change it, the "RED needle grabber". We can even give you a free needle booklet that shows more details, just ask us for one.


