

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION:

In-person registration for Religious Education Classes for grades K-8 will take place in the church hall on Sunday, Aug. 31 after the 8:30 a.m. Mass. Online registration forms are available on the parish website. Fill in the blanks and submit by 8/31. Parents and Guardians should be aware that all parish children MUST RECEIVE First Penance. First Communion and Confirmation at St. Leo. If the children attend Catholic elementary schools, they will not receive these sacraments with their classmates. Rather, the diocese wishes all children to receive their sacraments at their home parishes. It is imperative that these children register for their sacraments on or before 8/31, so we have their contact information. Finally, all parents who wish their children to receive these sacraments must show that the students have been attending religious education classes either at Catholic schools or at St. Leo from grade one.


