




#### Observing the Season of Advent

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent, meaning "to come to" is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

Advent devotions including the Advent wreath, remind us of the meaning of the season. An Advent calendar (like the one offered on the US Bishops website: usccb.org) can help you fully enter into the season with daily activities and prayers to prepare you spiritually for the birth of Jesus Christ.


