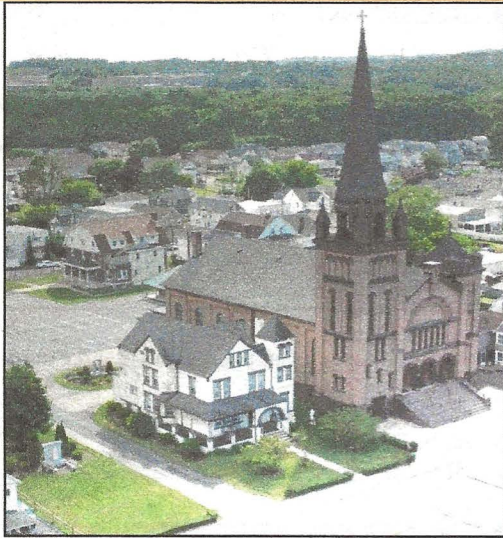

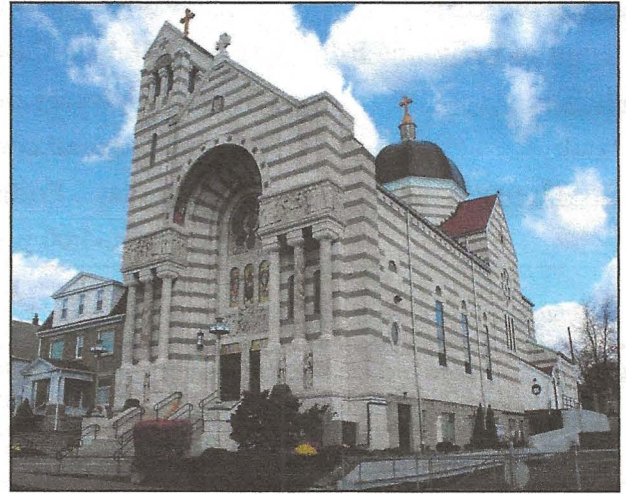

### Readings for Sunday, June 14, 2026

**First Reading:** Therefore, if you hearken to my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all other people, though all the earth is mine. (Exodus 19:5)

**Psalm:** We are his people: the sheep of his flock. (Psalm 100)

**Second Reading:** But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

**Gospel:** At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. (Matthew 9:36)

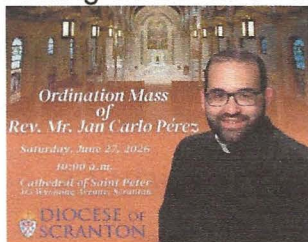
**JUNE, THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS:** During June we honor the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We pray the novena and the Litany of the Sacred Heart. We pray that Jesus blesses us and keeps us closer to His Sacred Heart.

**FATHER'S DAY ENVELOPES:** Please remember to pray for your Father by noting his name on your Father's Day envelope. You can drop it in the collection basket or send it to the rectory. Father Dang will pray for all Fathers (living and deceased) at every Mass during the month of June. Thank you for loving our Fathers.

**FATHER'S DAY CANDLES:** The last day to submit candle requests for Father's Day is Monday, June 15.

**SAINT JOHN VIANNEY on THE REAL PRESENCE:** St. John Vianney (1786 - 1859) renowned French priest canonized in 1925, viewed the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist as the absolute center of the Christian faith. He famously declared, "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." Vianney taught that upon receiving Holy Communion, "the adorable Blood of Jesus Christ really flows in our veins and His Flesh is really blended with ours." St. John Vianney strongly opposed immediately reading or speaking after receiving the Eucharist. Instead, he advised the faithful to listen quietly to what God is saying directly to their hearts. On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, pray for a true understanding of the Eucharist as the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

**FIRST WORLDWIDE MARIAN PROCESSION:** On Saturday, June 13, at 3:00 p.m., St. Leo and St. Andrew parishioners will gather at the Blessed Mother Statue (alongside the St. Leo Rectory) to pray the Rosary for World Peace and other intentions. Representatives from our parish organizations will lead the rosary. Please plan to be a part of this worldwide prayer to Our Mother, Mary. Bring a lawn chair if you wish. Folding chairs will be available.

There will also be an opportunity to pray an Ordination Novena for Deacon Pérez on the Vocation Office's social media platforms beginning on June 18.

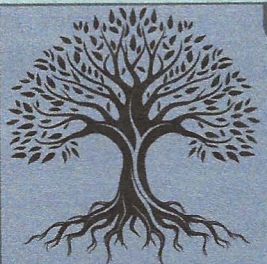
