THE COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAMME AT QUEEN'S COLLEGE

Students in Grades 7 to 12 are required to earn community service hours each year. Community service involves giving of one's time, free of charge to an individual or organization that benefits from your help.

COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS REQUIRED AT EACH GRADE LEVEL

These are the minimum recommended hours:

Grade 7: 5 hours Grade 8: 5 hours Grade 9: 10 hours
Grade 10: 10 hours Grade 11: 15 hours Grade 12: 20 hours

WHY IS COMPLETING MY REQUIRED COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS IMPORTANT?

- It is a requirement for promotion to the next grade level
- It is a graduation requirement
- Colleges view favorably, those applicants who have engaged in substantial community service. This gives the student an edge over other applicants.
- It is a requirement needed to earn a Bahamas High School Diploma

EXAMPLES OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Supervised tutoring, without pay
- Supervised school or beach cleanup
- Babysitting for a school event, e.g. PTA meeting, Parents' Day
- Assisting at school functions
- Working with a community agency; e.g. Red Cross, Humane Society etc.



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Each time community service is performed, the student should present this card to the person who is responsible for overseeing the community service.
2. The time that the student begins and ends the community service should be recorded, as well as the total time in hours.
3. The person overseeing the community service is also asked to fill in the name of the organization as well as, sign this form.
4. **DEADLINE** – Before the end of April of each school year, make a copy of this report and submit to the counsellor assigned to your grade level.
