As we enter the final stretch of the academic year, we look forward to continuing our partnership with you to ensure the success of every QC Comet. An important part of our end-of-year preparations is assessment. These assessments allow us to monitor student growth and make any necessary adjustments to support continued progress.

End-of-year examinations for **Grades One, Two, Four, and Five** are scheduled for the week of **Tuesday, May 26, 2026, to Thursday, May 28, 2026**. Please note that **Monday, May 25, 2026, is a Whit Monday holiday**, and there will be no school on that day.

A detailed examination schedule is provided below. Additionally, a list of concepts and skills that will be assessed will be shared by classroom teachers. **Review Week** is scheduled for the week of **May 18, 2026**. During this time, homework will continue to be assigned to support revision and practice.

Kindly note the following:

- Students will be dismissed at **12:30 p.m.** on each examination day.
- **Friday, May 29, 2026**, will serve as a **marking day for teachers**. Students are not required to attend school on this day.

Tips to help at home:

- Establish an at-home review routine/schedule. Ensure that this meets your child's needs. (Do they require small chunks with multiple breaks? Are longer sessions beneficial?)
- Write information down on paper or index cards.

- Use hands-on activities and manipulatives (e.g., counters or popsicle sticks)
- Make connections to everyday life
- Allow students to “teach” you
- Make review sessions FUN
- Praise your child! Confidence is half the battle. Ensure that they know while your expectations may be high, you are proud of their work during the review.

Parents, as we prepare our young learners for their examinations, kindly ensure they have had a good night’s rest and nutritious breakfast and come to school in FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM prepared with three sharpened pencils each examination day. Students should arrive at school by 8:15 a.m. to ensure they are not disconcerted but rather have time to settle before the start of their exams.
