UNIFORM CODE FOR BOYS



SHIRT

White, short sleeved shirt with standard, red QC embroidered monogram.



PANTS

Dark grey long or short pants (not charcoal grey). No cords or jeans style. Trousers should not be too short or baggy or sagging. Pants must fit at the waist.



BELT

Plain black.



SOCKS

Grey or black.



SHOES

Black only. No boots or shoes above the ankle bone. No suede, metal decorations or toe caps. Black patent not acceptable.



NECKTIE

Hunter green and grey striped ties are mandatory for Grades 4-6.



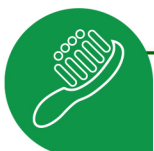
UNDERSHIRT

Plain white only.



JACKET/BLAZER

Hunter green only.



HAIRSTYLES

No inappropriate hairstyles e.g. Mohawk. No lines or zigzag cuts. Shaved heads and contrasting long hair are not allowed. Please communicate these instructions to your barber. Boys' hairstyles should be kept 'low'. No braids.





JEWELRY

Earrings are boys not allowed. Only school sanctioned pins and buttons are allowed. A simple wristwatch may be worn. No smartwatches allowed. Chains and rings not allowed.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

SHORTS

Hunter green shorts.

T-SHIRT

Solid House colour with school crest.

SOCKS

Plain white, with or without trim.

FOOTWEAR

Tennis shoes.



SWIMMING

TRUNKS

Plain black swimsuit.

T-SHIRT

Long, plain white t-shirt for travel to and from the pool or white t-shirt with House crest/ any Q.C. T-shirt.

FOOTWEAR

Crocs or rubber sole sandals.



T-SHIRT DAYS

JEANS

Long jeans, with no rips or holes.

T-SHIRT

Any QC shirt (e.g. the Peace t-shirt, QC Comets t-shirt, the house P.E. t-shirt or any QC club t-shirt)

FOOTWEAR

School tennis shoes or regular school shoes. Slippers or tennis with various colors are not allowed.



GENERAL COMMENTS

- All articles of clothing should be clearly labeled with child's name and grade.
- Students in incorrect uniform should carry an explanatory note from a parent. It is expected that the student will be correctly dressed the following day.
- Students who are not dressed according to instructions given for a trip may not be allowed to participate.
- Please ensure that the person purchasing uniforms for your child is fully aware of the school's uniform regulations, especially when purchasing shoes. Do not allow your child to persuade you to buy the incorrect uniform.
- Children should not change into non-uniform clothes when down the drive at the close of school.
