



QUEEN'S COLLEGE PRIMARY YEARS

UNIFORM CODE FOR GIRLS



DRESS

Green and white striped A-line dress with bust darts, visible patch pockets, round neckline and centre back zipper.



BLOUSE

Plain short sleeved shirt with a round (peter pan) to be worn beneath the dress.



SKIRT

Regular school skirt or culottes skirt in regulation green and white stripe.



BLOUSE

Regulation school fabric, shirt style blouse with short sleeves.



SHOES

Black, flat shoes with firm enclosed uppers. Minimal decoration.



TIGHTS

Plain green or white tights may be worn.



SOCKS

Green or white. Long or short.



JACKETS/BLAZERS/SWEATERS

School approved hunter green only.



HAIRSTYLES

Simple hairstyles that do not fall across the face. Extensions are not allowed. Hair accessories should be small and simple in green, white or black. Beads are not permitted.



JEWELRY

Plain stud earrings or a sleeper sized hoops are the only styles allowed. A simple wristwatch may be worn. No smartwatches allowed. Chains and rings not allowed.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

SHORTS

Hunter green shorts.

T-SHIRT

Solid House colour with school crest.

SOCKS

Plain white, with or without trim.

FOOTWEAR

Tennis shoes.



SWIMMING

SWIMSUIT

Plain black swimsuit.

SWIM CAP

All girls must wear a cap for swimming.

T-SHIRT

Long, plain white t-shirt for travel to and from the pool or white t-shirt with House crest/ any Q.C. T-shirt.

FOOTWEAR

Crocs or rubber sole sandals.



T-SHIRT DAYS

JEANS

Long jeans, with no rips or holes.

T-SHIRT

Any QC shirt (e.g. the Peace t-shirt, QC Comets t-shirt, the house P.E. t-shirt or any QC club t-shirt)

FOOTWEAR

School tennis shoes or regular school shoes. Slippers or tennis with various colors are not allowed.



GENERAL COMMENTS

- Nail polish is not allowed.
- All articles of clothing should be clearly labeled with child's name and grade.
- Students in incorrect uniform should carry an explanatory note from a parent. It is expected that the student will be correctly dressed the following day.
- Students who are not dressed according to instructions given for a trip may not be allowed to participate.
- Please ensure that the person purchasing uniforms for your child is fully aware of the school's uniform regulations, especially when purchasing shoes. Do not allow your child to persuade you to buy the incorrect uniform.
- Children should not change into non-uniform clothes when down the drive at the close of school.
