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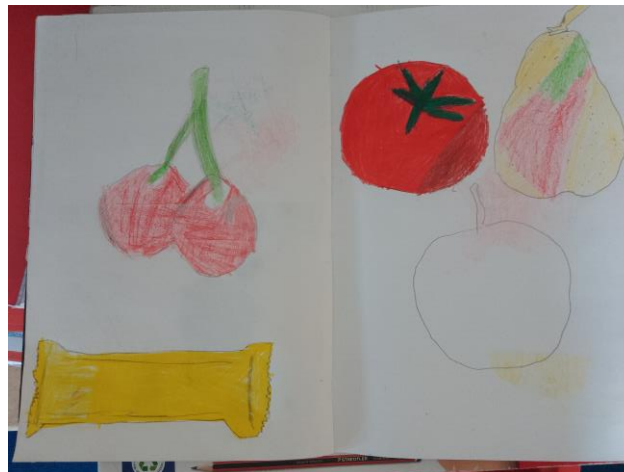

During our Art lessons this term, the children have focused on tone, texture, and the formal elements of art. They have produced some truly impressive pieces that showcase their creativity and developing skills.

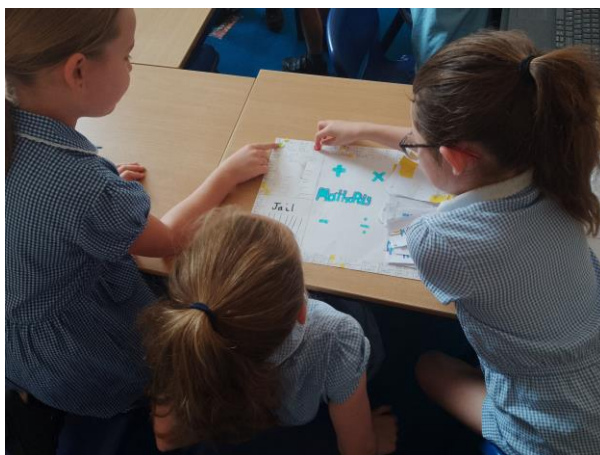
On Monday, the whole year group had the opportunity to watch the Year 6 leavers' dress rehearsal before they move on to the next stage of their journey.

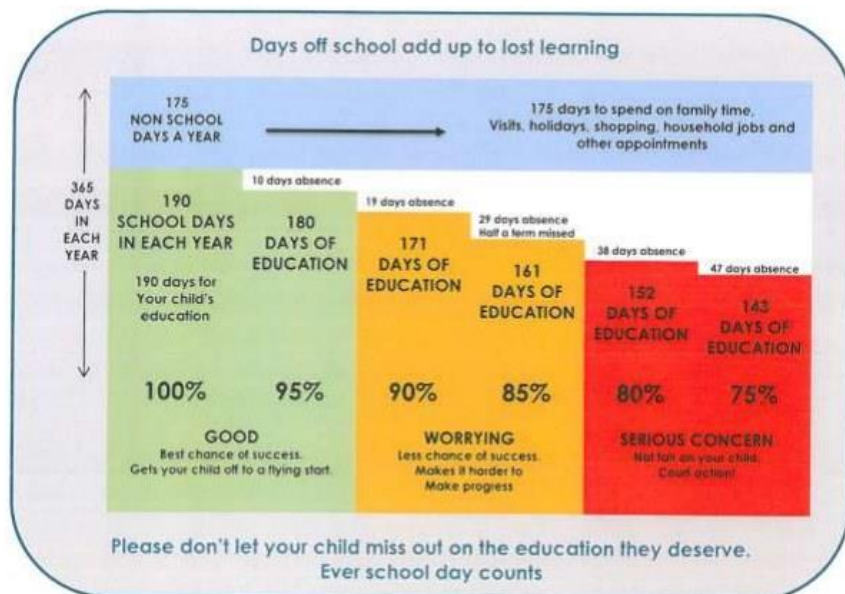
