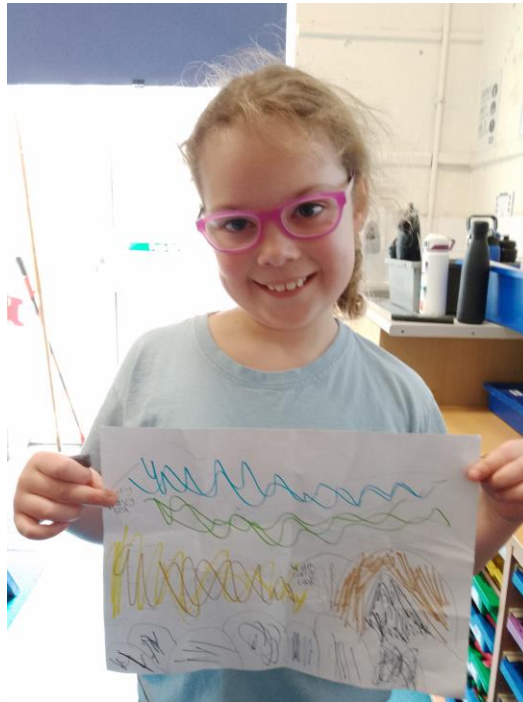

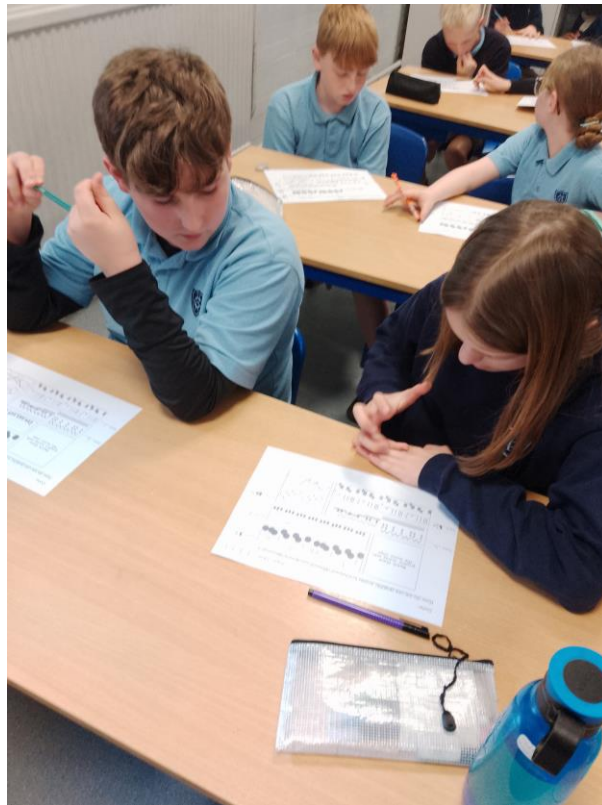
Year 6

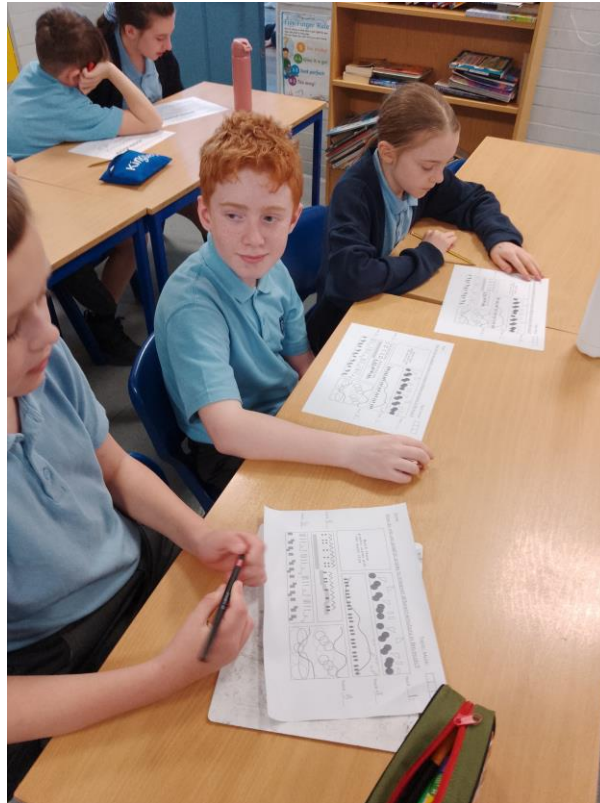

A big well done to Year 6 for their hard work and dedication this week! Keep up the fantastic effort, and let's continue to support each other in our learning journey.

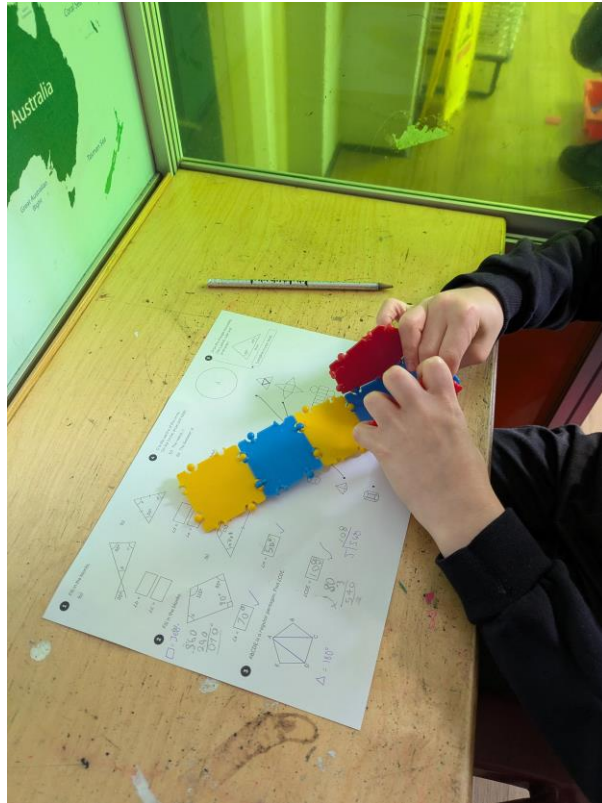

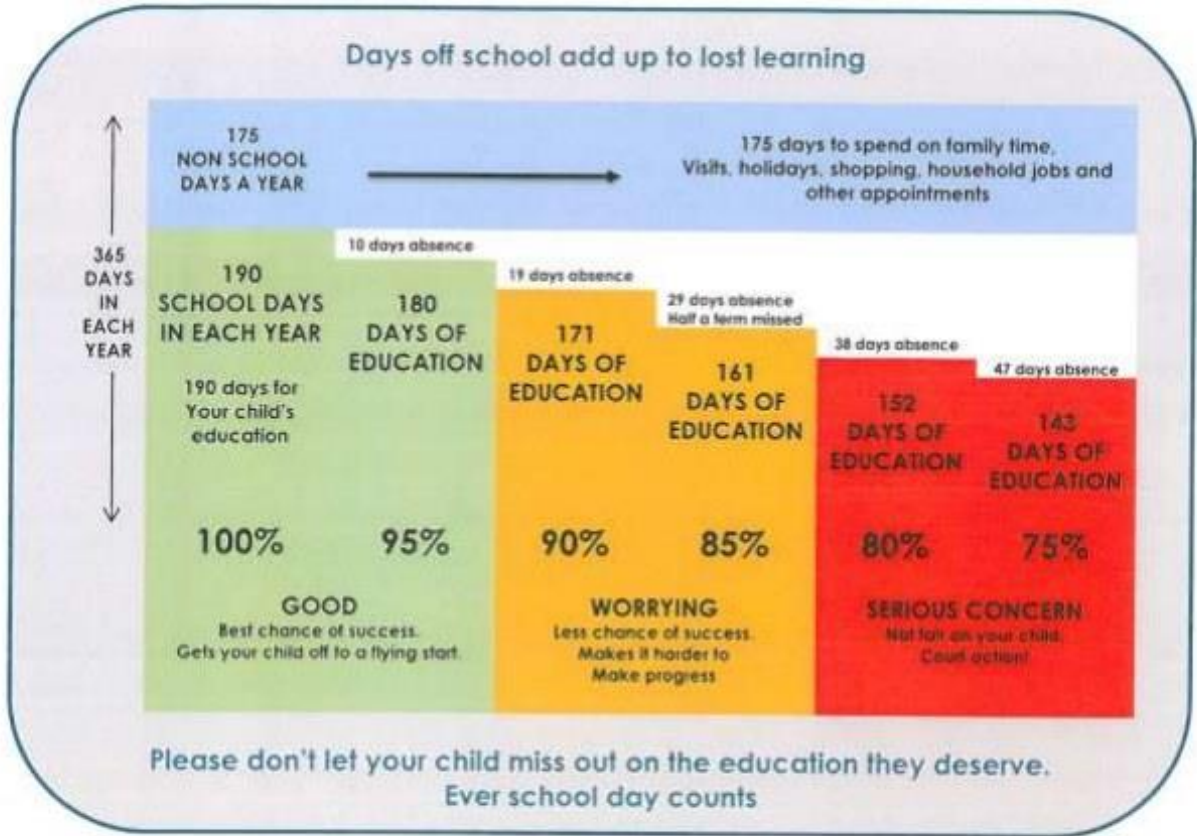


