"Temple questions" that arise from 1 Kings 6-7:

- 1. Is the LORD worthy of such a place?
- 2. Is the gathering of God's people worthy of such a place?
- 3. Who will we worship?
- 4. Will we continue to obey God?

"Temple Questions" that arise from Jesus:

- 1. Do we grasp who Jesus is?
- 2. Do we grasp what Jesus has done for us?

Sermon Ouestions

- 1. Which description of Solomon's temple is your favorite? Why so?
- 2. Why is *the LORD* worthy of a place like Solomon's temple?
 - a. How can we tell God how glorious we think He is?
 - b. How can we *show the world* how glorious we think God is?
- 3. Why is the gathering of God's people to worship worthy of a place like the temple?
 - a. What will our lives look like when we *don't* value the worship gathering?
 - b. What will our lives look like when we do value the worship gathering?

- 4. Is there anything you're tempted to *prioritize* over God?
 - a. How can you fend off that temptation?
 - b. How can you strengthen your commitment to God?
- 5. Solomon obeyed God by building the temple, but then God called Solomon to *keep* obeying Him in 1 Kings 6:11-13.
 - a. Why did God need to do this?
 - b. Can you relate to this in any way?
- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 6:18-20.
 - a. What strikes you about reading that *you're* a temple after reading about the construction of Solomon's temple?
 - b. How does being a temple of the Holy Spirit fuel your *obedience?* Your *joy?* Your *identity?*
- 7. Any other takeaways from this passage or message?
