Discussion Questions

1. What did you learn today from the Scripture passage(s) that you didn't know before? What is something that hit you in a fresh way?
2. What is the primary way we *see* or "behold" God? Why is it good and right to regularly behold him in that way?
3. What part of Isaiah 40 has ministered to you most? What about God has most encouraged you?
4. How have you experienced who Isaiah 40:30 says you are?
5. How does Isaiah 40:30's description of you *encourage* you? In what ways is it at the same time *discouraging* to you?
6. Jesus says in John 15:5: "Apart from me you can do nothing." How does that jive with Isaiah 40:30?
7. In Isaiah 40:28, the prophet offers a sort of mini-summary of everything he's told us in the rest of the chapter. Why are Biblical reminders *good*? Why do we need them?
8. What would the implications if God *did* faint and grow weary?
9. Take a few minutes to look through the Bible and find some passages that showcase God's unlimited power and strength.

10. In what ways have you experienced God giving *you* strength?

11. What does it mean practically for *you* to “wait on the Lord” (Isaiah 40:31)?

12. Read Hebrews 12:1-2. How does looking to *Jesus* help you persevere in running the race he’s set before you?
