

Discussion Questions for “The Unstoppable Gospel: Healing”
Acts 3:1-10, Pastor Tom Olson, Weekend of May 23rd & 24th, 2026

Sermon Outline

This healing sings of Jesus:

- It can only be accomplished by Him (vv. 1-6).
- It bears witness to His resurrection (v. 7).
- It proclaims that He’s the Christ (v. 8).
- It brings Him glory (vv. 8-10).
- It affirms and platforms the preaching of His Word (Acts 2:22-3:26).

Three reflections on this healing:

1. Biblical healings sing about Jesus, not about us.
2. God sometimes gives earthly healing, but sometimes He doesn’t.
3. Jesus will heal every Christian’s body eternally.

Sermon Questions

1. This passage sings of Jesus in many ways. Which is most encouraging and/or clarifying to you?
2. Why is it important to see that this passage is ultimately about Jesus?
3. What might happen if we read this passage as a story about us instead of Christ?
4. Have you ever been thankful, in retrospect, for an “unanswered” prayer?
 - a. What was the situation?
 - b. Why did you end up being thankful?
5. Share the story of a believer you know who’s honored Christ in sickness or in death.
 - a. How did they do this?
 - b. What God-given impact did it make on you and others?
6. It is right and good to pray for healing – whether directly through God’s hand or as He uses doctors and nurses. That said, how might Acts 3 shape the way you pray for healing for yourself or loved ones moving forward?
7. Take some time to share requests and pray for one another along these lines right now.
8. Any other takeaways from this passage or message?
