Questions:

- 1. What stood out to you most from this week's sermon, and why?
- 2. David said, "You lifted me up." Where in your life have you felt like you were "in the pit," and how did God pull you out?
- 3. Psalm 30 shows that God hears our cry. How does knowing that God always hears, even when He seems silent shape the way you pray?
- 4. David recognized that his sickness was God's loving discipline. How can we tell the difference between God's discipline and ordinary suffering in a broken world?
- 5. What are some ways pride can quietly grow in our hearts during seasons of success? How can we guard against that pride before it takes root?
- 6. How have you seen God use discipline or hardship to change your heart or draw you closer to Him? What did that experience teach you about His character?
- 7. Psalm 30 ends with praise: "You turned my mourning into dancing." What does this verse teach us about God's ability to redeem even our lowest moments?
- 8. Romans 8:28 says that God works all things for good. How can we hold on to that truth when the outcome we hoped for doesn't happen?
