Questions:

- 1. What stood out to you most from this week's sermon, and why?
- 2. In Matthew 6:19–21, Jesus warns about storing up "treasures on earth." What are some examples of treasures people commonly pursue today? How do these compare with the treasures in heaven?
- 3. Jesus says, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." How does what we value most reveal where our heart truly is?
- 4. Why is greed harder to recognize in ourselves compared to other sins like anger or lust? Can you think of a time when you may have turned a "blind eye" to greed without realizing it?
- 5. How does serving money (instead of God) lead to greater anxiety, emptiness, or even ruin? Can you think of examples from Scripture or from today?
- 6. The sermon gave examples of how family, reputation, or career can become treasures that control us. Which of these do you think people in our community are most tempted to treasure above God?
- 7. Pastor Tom shared a personal story about trusting God's provision when entering ministry. When have you had to trust God to provide for you or your family? How did He show His faithfulness?
- 8. Jesus promises in Matthew 6:33, "Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." What does seeking first the kingdom look like for you right now?
