Sermon Outline

What does the Spirit want to do *through* us?

1. Reach the nations (vv. 1-21).
2. Proclaim Christ (vv. 16-40).
3. Love sacrificially (vv. 41-47)

Sermon Questions

1. *Why* does God want to reach the nations?
 - a. Do you share His motivation?
 - b. If not, what’s holding you back?
2. Identify some specific opportunities you *already* have to reach the nations in your neighborhood, workplace, or school.
3. Have you ever thought of *going* to the nations on a short-term or long-term trip?
4. Jesus instructs the first Christians to proclaim Him (Acts 1:8). And as soon as they’re filled with the Spirit, that’s what they do – both *together* (Acts 2:11) and Peter, *specifically* (Acts 2:16-40).
 - a. How can we tell that this is not just *their* calling, but *our* calling, too?
 - b. Think of evidence both *inside and outside* today’s passage.
5. How is our calling to proclaim Christ...
 - a. *...clarifying?*
 - b. *...convicting?*
 - c. *...encouraging?*
6. When’s a time that *you* were loved sacrificially?
7. Who needs *your* sacrificial love?
 - a. Are there obstacles in the way?
 - b. How can these be overcome?
8. Any other takeaways from this passage or message?
