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**Lead teams, manage budgets, deliver complex healthcare facilities**

## Assistant Project Manager / Project Engineer

**\$70K-\$85K**

Entry Point | 0-3 Years Experience | Typical Duration: 2-3 years

**Your entry into healthcare construction project management. You'll support senior PMs while learning the fundamentals of healthcare projects, from infection control protocols to medical equipment coordination.**

### Key Responsibilities:

- Assist with project documentation, submittals, and RFIs
- Coordinate with subcontractors and vendors
- Track project schedules and budgets
- Support site meetings and client communications
- Learn ICRA protocols and healthcare-specific requirements

- Procore, Bluebeam, MS Project basics
- Healthcare codes and FGI Guidelines

# CAREER TRANSITION STRATEGIES



## From General Construction to Healthcare

**Timeline: 6-12 months to become competitive**

- › Take online courses in FGI Guidelines and healthcare codes
- › Network with healthcare construction professionals
- › Target smaller healthcare projects initially (MOBs, clinics)
- › Highlight transferable skills: occupied building experience, complex MEP, etc.
- › Consider lateral move at lower level to gain healthcare experience



## From Field to Office (Superintendent to PM)

**Timeline: 1-2 years with intentional development**

- › Pursue PMP or CCM certification
- › Develop proficiency in Procore, MS Project, estimating software
- › Shadow PMs and participate in budget/schedule meetings
- › Take on APM role first to bridge the gap
- › Build client-facing communication skills



## From Office to Field (PM to Superintendent)

**Timeline: 6-18 months (less common transition)**

- › Spend significant time on active jobsites
- › Learn trade-specific knowledge and sequences
- › Build relationships with subcontractors
- › Start as assistant superintendent
- › Earn OSHA certifications and jobsite safety credentials



## From Allied Fields (Architecture, Engineering)

**Timeline: Immediate to 6 months**

- › Leverage existing healthcare design experience
- › Target BIM/VDC roles or technical specialist positions
- › Emphasize healthcare project knowledge and FGI familiarity
- › Network within contractor organizations you've worked with
