Brittany Amos Announces Campaign for Forsyth County School Board District 1 *Focused on Keeping Forsyth County Schools Great*

Forsyth County, GA — Conservative Republican Brittany Amos, a mom of two Forsyth County Schools students, small business owner, and longtime advocate for parents and students, announced today that she is running for Forsyth County School Board, District 1.

Brittany says her campaign is about protecting what makes Forsyth County Schools great - high standards, safe schools, parental involvement, and classrooms focused on learning, not politics.

“Forsyth County didn’t become one of the best school systems in Georgia by accident,” Brittany said. “It happened because our community stayed focused on education first. I’m running to help keep our schools great by protecting high standards, listening to parents, and making sure classrooms stay focused on learning.”

Brittany has spent years actively serving in Forsyth County schools and brings firsthand experience as both a parent and an education advocate. She is a former substitute teacher in Forsyth County Schools, has served as PTO President at Cumming Elementary School and Otwell Middle School, and has worked closely with parents, teachers, and administrators through service on Local School Councils and advisory boards.

Her background also includes early experience working for Republican leaders Johnny Isakson, Saxby Chambliss, and Karen Handel, eight years of service on the Cumming Housing Authority Board, and nearly a decade mentoring the same Forsyth County student from elementary school through high school.

Brittany says the School Board has made important progress getting back to the basics of education and believes it is critical to protect that direction.

“Classrooms should be places where kids are allowed to be kids, teachers are empowered to teach, and parents are respected,” she said. “I will oppose woke policies, classroom indoctrination, and political agendas that distract from student success.”

If elected, Brittany says she will work to ensure consistency in excellence across every Forsyth County school — whether a school is Title I or brand new — so that all students have access to safe, well-supported, high-performing schools.

As a School Board member, Brittany Amos will focus on:

- Consistency in excellence across all Forsyth County schools

- Protect taxpayers, budget conservatively, and oppose increases to the tax burden on families
