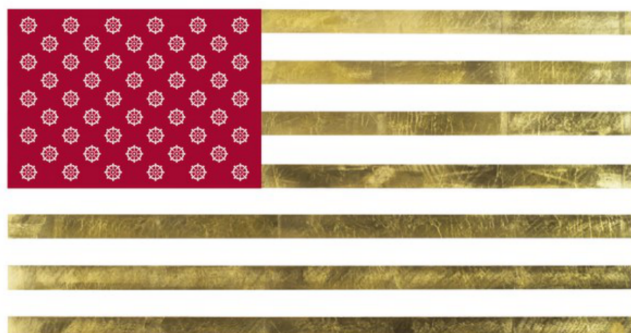
Introducing three diverse new collections, "Pretty Ugly", "Flying Colours" and "Cityscapes", here's what to expect from the multimedia conceptual artist:

In Eastern philosophy it is believed that everything and everyone has a dark side and light side, or yin and yang. The shadow cannot exist without the light and in "Pretty Ugly", Skene highlights this juxtaposition through various portraits that reveal how something can be pretty on the outside yet ugly within

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Flying Colours

"Flying Colours" takes an political look at national flags, dissecting each of their geometries down to socio-economic and geo-political implications. The stars and stripes of the USA, for instance, are featured prominently in this collection to discuss the nation's position as a dominant world superpower, its wide political diversity and an influence that is both progressive and regressive.

Cityscapes

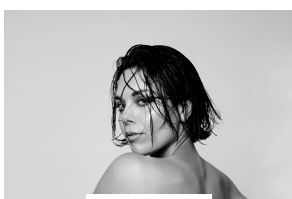

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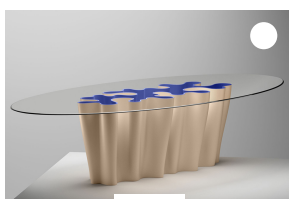
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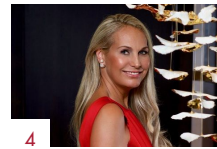
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
