

### English-

We will be start by using Talk for Writing techniques to get to know our story; Once Upon a Fairy Tale by Natalia and Lauren O' Hara and then to innovate and invent our own stories. We will move onto writing about Harvest, Remembrance and retelling the Christmas Story.

### History-

We will be learning about changes within living memory.

We are going to learn about how we grow and change, and about how toys have changed since our teachers were pupils!

Music-We will learn to identify different sounds and to change and use sounds. We will learn to discriminate between longer and shorter sounds and to use them to create interesting sequences of sound. We will also be learning songs for our Christmas show, 'Hosannah Rock'.

### Computing-

In the programming section of our learning, we will begin to develop / reinforce understanding of the word 'algorithm' through looking at examples and giving instructions to each other. The children will give instructions to program an algorithm and follow a set of instructions. We will talk about debugging the sequence to make amendments to the algorithm.

### Maths-

The children will continue to develop their reasoning and problem solving skills across all areas of maths. We will be focusing on Place Value and making sure we are secure with the number system. The children will learn about addition and subtraction using a variety of resources to support them.

### Science-

This term we will be thinking about the animals including humans.

We will learn about our senses, how animals and people grow and change, find out about what animals, including humans, need to survive and how to stay healthy.

### Art and Design-

We will be using the Access Art Programme to create Spirals using different mediums.

Later in the term will be all about Christmas-cards, decorations and lots of glitter!

RE- In RE the children will continue to listen to Bible stories, with a focus on Harvest and The Creation. Our values this term are Friendship and Love.

### PE-

This term's focus is Gymnastics. The children will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.
