English

In English we will be writing stories based on Traditional Tales. We will also be writing about the Coronation of King Charles. In the second part of the term we will be writing about Water as this is our overarching topic and also our memories of the time spent at St. Cuthbert's Infant School. We will continue to be learning our spellings, grammar and punctuation.

History/Geography

We will be basing our History around the Coronation of King Charles and learning about other Kings and Queens in History. In Geography we will be learning about Oceans and Seas, including Charles Darwin.

Maths

Maths focuses on the four operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication) and fractions. 'Active Maths' takes place weekly where the children consolidate their maths knowledge through a variety of fun Maths games and Maths fluency takes place during the week to help build the skills the children need. Both classes will also be doing time, capacity, weight and position and direction.

Science: In Science, we will be learning about plants, habitats and homes. We will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. We will be comparing the differences between living, dead and never been alive.

P.E

This term we will be focusing on our athletics skills and practising for our sports day. Children will be learning how to maintain a run over different distances and engage in competitive races. We will be learning how to perform a variety of different jumps and learning how to throw different types of equipment in different ways, for accuracy and distance.

Art and Design

Computing

Maple-We will use Bee-Bots to collect information about animals. We will learn how to program a robot to do a particular task using the correct vocabulary. We will program algorithms and talk about them. We will learn how to recognise mistakes in algorithms and debug them.

Oak-Using JIT, we will learn how to; program software to do a particular task, use the word debug when we correct mistakes when we program and watch a program execute and spot where it goes wrong so that we can debug it.

Both-We will think about what is the internet is and what is the World Wide Web? Look at the validity of information that we find on the Internet using Apple Ant website. We will consider where the information for the school website comes from.

R.E-

In R.E this term, we will be learning about Humanism, Judaism and God and the Covenant. Our Christian values for this term are forgiveness and courage. We will be discussing this value in the classroom and in collective worships.

Music

In Music we will be exploring timbre, tempo and dynamics. We will also be exploring sounds. The children continue to sing songs, play percussion instruments and understand a simple score. We will also be performing 'Pirates and Mermaids' at the end of the year.
