## **English**

In English we will be writing stories based on Traditional Tales. We will also be writing about the Coronation of King Charles. In the second part of the term we will be writing about Water as this is our overarching topic and also our memories of the time spent in Year 1. We will continue to be learning our spellings, grammar and punctuation.

## History/Geography

We will be basing our History around the Coronation of King Charles and learning about other Kings and Queens in History. In Geography we will be learning about Oceans and Seas, including Charles Darwin.

### Maths

We will then move on to multiplication and division where we will count in 2's, 5's and 10's, make equal groups and share into groups. This term we will be carrying on with our learning of Place Value to 100. We shall use number lines, part whole models, number shapes and tens frames to represent two-digit numbers. Our learning will also centre around fractions where we will be finding  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$  of objects. We will end the term with some work on position and direction, time and money.

#### Science

In Science, we will be learning about plants, habitats and homes. We will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. We will be comparing the differences between living, dead and never been alive.

# Art and Design

In Art and Design we will be designing banners of Kings and Queens. These will be on display in the foyer. We continue to evaluate all our work along the way.

## Computing

Using JIT, we will learn how to; program software to do a particular task, use the word debug when we correct mistakes when we program and watch a program execute and spot where it goes wrong so that we can debug it.

#### PE

This term will be focusing on our athletics skills and practising for our sports day. Children will be learning how to maintain a run over different distances and engage in competitive races. We will be learning how to perform a variety of different jumps and learning how to throw different types of equipment in different ways, for accuracy and distance.
