As well as this we will be practicing how to apply this knowledge in our writing. Children will be encouraged to use finger spaces and shown where capital letters and full stops belong. We will be focusing on traditional tales and retelling them

Understanding the World-

We will be learning about the Royal family and the Coronation of King Charles III. The children will focus and learn about a monarch from the past. We will also be comparing and contrasting characters from stories, including figures from the past. We will also be looking at plants and growing and identifying what a plant needs to grow and observing the changes from seed to plant over the term.

Summer 2023

Physical- This term the focus in PE is athletics and Sports Day. The children will be learning how to run a race and how to stay in lane. They will learn a variety of races, such as egg and spoon and will practice jumping over hurdles. We will be looking at what constitutes a healthy life style and during Healthy schools week we will look at how we take care of our bodies and why it is important to brush our teeth. We will also be taking part in our sponsored bounce day.

Personal, Social and Emotional-

We will be following the Jigsaw programme and will be looking at relationships. What it means to be a good friend and how we can make new ones. We will also look at how we can play cooperatively and resolve any problems.

Expressive Arts and Design- Children will be using different media to design and make a class banner relating to their Monarch. They will be making crowns and taking on a role to act out our own versions of the King's Coronation. We will be learning a song about the King and perform it to the rest of the school. We will also learn the National Anthem. We will be making minibeasts out of clay - and encouraging the children to sculpt and mould their creations.
