

English-

We will be reading and re-telling our class story, the story *Five Bears* by Catherine Rayner. We will use the *Talk for Writing* approach, which encompasses a three-stage pedagogy, imitation, innovation and invention. We will be learning how to read back what we have written, use finger spaces and full stops.

History-

History- We will be exploring why Walter Tull is considered a significant person in History. Then we will move on to learning all about the History of toys, studying toys parents, grandparents and even great-grandparents may have played with, identifying changes in materials and technology.

Music-

In music we are learning to explore interesting sounds, the sounds that different instruments make and the sounds that are all around. Later in the term we will be thinking about duration of a sounds, whether it long or sort.

Computing-

This term children will be using our Bee-Bot programme, learning what happens when they press buttons on a robot Bee-Bot and using the Bee-Bot application. Children are beginning to understand what an algorithm is. Later in the term we will be using a children search engine always remembering to keep ourselves safe online.

Maths-

The children will continue to develop their knowledge of place value, taking small steps each day to build on prior learning. Children will learn how to sort and count objects, count on from a given number, think about one more and one less and begin to compare numbers. After that we will begin to learn about addition and subtraction.

Science-

This term we will be thinking about the animals including humans.

We will learn about how animals grow and change, find out about what animals, including humans, need to survive and how to stay healthy.

Art and Design-

We will be working on our displays at the start of this term. We will be making self-portraits and art work that represents who we are inside. We will also look at portraiture by the artist Frida Kahlo

Later in the term will be all about Christmas-cards, decorations and lots of glitter!

PE-

This term's focus is Gymnastics. The children will master basic movements including rolls, balancing whilst making different shapes with their bodies and jumps. Children will also learn how to create a sequence of movements with ta partner and learning how to use PE equipment safely.
