### English-

We will be start by using Talk for Writing techniques to get to know our class story, and then to innovate and invent our own stories. We will be reading and re-telling our class story. We will be using the story Five Bears by Catherine Rayner

### History-

History- We will be exploring why Walter Tull is considered a significant person in History. Then we will move on to learning all about the History of toys, studying toys parents, grandparents and even great-grandparents may have played with, identifying changes in materials and technology.

### Music-

We will learn to identify different sounds and to change and use sounds. We will learn to discriminate between longer and shorter sounds and to use them to create interesting sequences of sound. We will also be learning songs for our Christmas show; 'The Little Fir Tree'.

### Computing-

In the programming section of our learning, we will begin to develop / reinforce understanding of the word 'algorithm' through looking at examples and giving instructions to each other. The children will give instructions to program an algorithm and follow a set of instructions. We will talk about debugging the sequence to make amendments to the algorithm.

### Maths-

The children will continue to develop their reasoning and problem solving skills across all areas of maths. We will be focusing on Place Value and making sure we are secure with the number system. We will be thinking about finding 10 more and 10 less. The children will learn about addition and subtraction using a variety of resources to support them.

# Who am I?

Year 2

#### Science-

This term we will be thinking about the animals including humans.

We will learn about how animals grow and change, find out about what animals, including humans, need to survive and how to stay healthy.

### Art and Design-

We will be working on our displays at the start of this term. We will be making self-portraits and art work that represents who we are inside. We will also look at portraiture by the artist Frida Kahlo

Later in the term will be all about Christmascards, decorations and lots of glitter!

This term's focus is Gymnastics. The children will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.
