OUR FUTURE PLANS: A "ground up" building in Paragould Arkansas and an infill for a building at New Horizon Baptist Church in Ward Arkansas.

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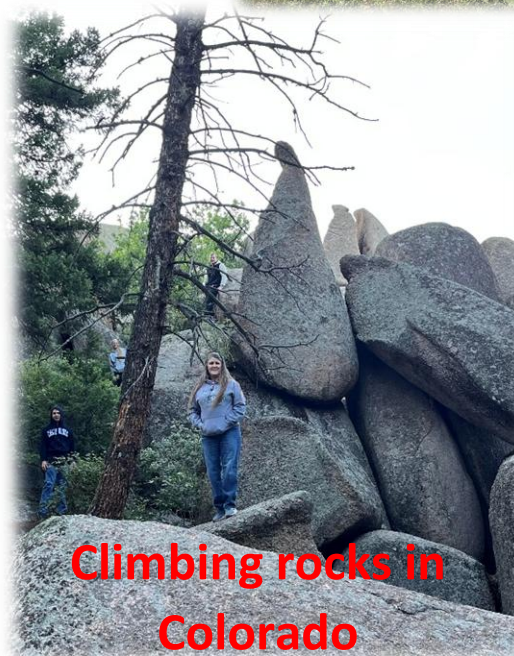
