We arrived in Papua New Guinea April 16th! We then made it to our Island, New Britain, on the 17th, one day before Youth Camp started. This last Sunday my Grandfather lead the two churches he pastors in voting on me to fill in for him while he and my Grandmother are on furlough.

I am also teaching in the Bible College now. The classes are in pidgin, which is great for me as it immerses me once again in the language. I have found that my fluency in speaking pidgin is quickly returning. Please pray for me as seek to serve the Lord in all these ministries. Also, I plead for prayers for my wife and children as they continue to adapt to our new lives. There are many changes that have taken place, and the culture is very different, pray that the Lord grant patience and wisdom for all of us as face each of these things.
