They declared that they would also like to have church in their Home.

Bro. Jamie asked them if they knew the Lord as their personal Saviour? One boy replied "Yes." The other young man said that he was not saved. After we shared the Gospel with him, he said, **"I would like to get Saved." He bowed his head there in the parking lot and prayed to be saved!**

We talked with their counselor, that was with them, about the possibility of having services in their Home. **Please pray with us that the Lord will open the door to this Juvenile Home.**

A man in our church works in maintenance for the County. Recently I was talking with him about his job and discovered he does the maintenance at the Detention Center. He told me that he has seen a great change in the whole atmosphere in the Detention Center. He has noticed a difference in the attitude of the teens who regularly attend the services. He also said that one day as he was walking by the cafeteria during lunch time, he noticed all the boys with heads bowed and praying for their meal! Some of the officers have spotted several of the Juveniles having Bible Studies before bedtime. One of the Verses I use all the time with teens is: **Psa. 119:9 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word. The Word of God** does make a difference in our behavior!

We are diligently working to get a few more volunteers cleared, so we can expand our services to both the Detention Center and the Home. We are preparing for a Special Christmas service at the Detention Center on December 18th? Would you please pray for the Lord to use us to touch their hearts!

Thank you all for your faithful prayers and support. We are truly blessed for all that you do to help us reach the trouble youth with the Gospel.
