QUARTERLY UPDATE (JANUARY-MARCH) 2026

Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,



It's truly an honor and privilege to be able to print the Word of God, and send it all around the world! It's also a blessing when we're able to visit the countries that we print for, and personally share the Gospel! This past January and February, Lisa and I had the opportunity of visiting many churches across the Philippines and doing just that.

Most of the churches we visited had received the John and Romans booklets we sent in early 2025. We were blessed by the wonderful spirit, love for the Lord, generosity, and hospitality of these churches! During our visit, we were very, very busy, and had numerous opportunities to share the Gospel, teach, preach, and serve wherever needed.

Our first stop was to a church in Tacloban, where as soon as we entered onto the church property, we were greeted with a very large banner that welcomed us back! While there, we were able to participate in two church anniversary services (main church and a church plant), a missions conference, sweetheart banquet, mens/ladies meeting, medical mission, and distribution of John/Romans at a local high school.



I once again had the privilege of preaching and teaching while visiting all of these churches. I was honored to preach another anniversary service for a church that I visited in 2020. I also had the opportunity to give my testimony and speak to about 25 students at a local Bible College. One of the churches we visited did not allow shoes while standing in the pulpit...so for



During the medical mission trip, we helped set up medical stations, distribute John and Romans booklets, and share the Gospel with many in the small village. While at the high school, our team was able to distribute over 8K booklets within three hours! We then had numerous opportunities to share the Gospel and pray with hundreds of students. Many made professions of faith, and many actually came up to us asking, "Could you share the Gospel with me?" To God be the glory...it was truly an amazing time! What a joy to see their hunger for the



Gospel in the Philippines! While I had the privilege of preaching, Lisa had the privilege of teaching and speaking to pastors' wives, church ladies, and teaching lots and lots of children! One church had over 70 children in an outdoor class! After our time in Tacloban, we departed for the capital city of Manila. This is where we also sent a container of John/Romans last year. While in Manila, we visited seven churches, and one Bible College.



the first time ever...I preached in my socks! Every church we visited throughout the Philippines was so very kind ... and fed us... and fed us ... and fed us!! We had so much food that we felt like the fatted calf waiting for the slaughter ☺. The Lord moved in hearts during these services, and many decisions were made...to God be the glory!



Upon return from the Philippines, I attended a Home Missions Conference in Colorado. While there, I was able to connect with many church planters, and pastors, and promise thousands of personalized John/Romans booklets for their ministries. Shortly after the conference, I loaded up our cargo trailer with thousands of pounds of Scripture portions, and made a delivery to three of our Seedline ministries (Mitchell, SD, Sioux Falls, SD, and Tomah, WI). I picked up their completed booklets (Spanish), and dropped off more supplies to help with our next project (Croatia).

While on the road for this Scripture swap, I was also able to purchase a piece of equipment that's very helpful when making seedline/Scripture deliveries. For close to 10 years, we've had to move thousands of pounds of boxes and bundles by hand when swapping material. Now, we have a battery-operated pallet jack that does all the heavy lifting...cutting our loading time by 2/3, and saving what little strength us old guys have left ☺. I then made arrangements to ship 14 pallets of Spanish and English booklets for churches all across the United States, as well as Panama, Argentina, and Mexico.

Looking ahead this next quarter: We'll continue assembling booklets for Croatia (shipping late fall), and assembling booklets for US churches. We'll also begin our spring travels, visiting churches across the western US. Thanks again to all who help us get the Gospel to needy souls worldwide...keep **PRESS-ing On!!**
