Dear Praying Partners,

April 2026

I am grateful for the opportunity to update you on what the Lord has been doing in our lives over the past two months. It still feels somewhat surreal to Emily and me that we are here in Romania. The Lord has been exceedingly good to us, and our days have been full with language school, homeschooling our children, visa appointments, and adjusting to daily life in a new country. With the arrival of spring, we are also enjoying the beauty of God's creation as it comes to life all around us. Romania is truly a beautiful country, and our family is thankful to experience it firsthand.

Language school has been progressing well, and I believe we are making steady strides in learning Romanian. At times, the process feels slow, and I find myself wishing for quicker progress. However, I am reminded that we have not yet been here three months and that it is important not to rush what is foundational. Learning the language is essential for effective ministry, and it is far more important to learn it thoroughly than simply to learn it "well enough."

One of the things our family looks forward to most each week is Sunday. Gathering with the church to sing praises, pray together, and hear the Word of God preached has been a great encouragement and a consistent reminder of His love. We have already been blessed with several opportunities to serve. Emily has been helping in children's church and had the opportunity to speak at a ladies' luncheon. I have also been given opportunities to preach, for which I am very thankful. Preaching with an interpreter is a new experience and has required some adjustment, however this just challenges me all the more to learn the language.

More recently, we have had the privilege of serving at a local children's hospital. Emily and I have been able to spend time holding, caring for, and showing love to sick babies and children. It is deeply heartbreaking to see some of these little ones who have been left alone or abandoned. One young boy, only ten months old, has already been in the hospital for four months. We are praying for their health, their salvation, and their futures.

At the beginning of April, we had the privilege of hosting our director and his wife, Phillip and Sarah Pritchard. We are very thankful they took the time to visit and encourage our family. If you are part of a church or know someone considering missionary service, I would encourage you to pray about supporting or partnering with Preach Evangelistic Ministries. Their commitment to God's glory and to the long-term success of their missionaries has been made evidently clear with how supportive they have been during this transition time.

As we approach our 90th day in the country, we would especially appreciate your prayers regarding our immigration appointment. Our 90th day falls on May 19th, which is also the date of our visa appointment. We are praying that everything will go smoothly and that the judge will approve our visa at that time. If not, we would be required to leave Romania for 90 days. We have taken every precaution and gathered all the requested documentation. While there should be no reason for denial, we understand that approval is not guaranteed. Please pray that the Lord would grant favor in this matter.

Thank you for your continued prayers and support. They mean more to us than we can fully express and truly make a difference in our lives and ministry.
