Gratitude is everywhere these days—podcasts, books, mugs at Target, and yes, plenty of my sermons[©] Sometimes it can feel like we're being told to be thankful because we've forgotten how. In Luke 17, Jesus heals ten people with leprosy and only one turns back to say thank you. The other nine do the



sensible thing: they follow the rules, see the priest, go home, and get their lives back. It's an awesome picture of restoration—but maybe not a picture of *well-being*.

Here's the difference the Gospel nudges us to notice: it's one thing to be thankful, it's another thing to be mindful. All ten received a blessing. Only one paused long enough to trace that blessing back to its Source. Jesus tells that one: "Your faith has made you well." In other words, gratitude didn't just celebrate the cure—it opened the door to wholeness.

Gratitude re-threads us to God as the giver of every good gift. It pulls us out of isolation and back into relationship—with God, with others, and even with our own lives. And because it's relational, gratitude has to become concrete, practiced, embodied...or it slips away.

A small, pocket-sized practice

Recently, my daughter found three small smooth glass rocks in a little plastic bag outside our sanctuary doors. "What are these for?" she asked. I told her a woman from First Lutheran in Taylors Falls made them after a sermon on gratitude. Inside the bag were simple directions:

- Put three glass stones in your right pocket at the start of the day.
- As you encounter a moment of joy, peace, or gift, say, "Thank you, God," and move one stone to your left pocket.
- By day's end, all three should be in the left pocket. Then write down those three thank-you moments in a small prayer journal.

My daughter looked at the rocks, smiled, and said, "I think I'm going to try this." Proud dad moment. And confession: I still need to follow up with her. Because again—it's one thing to be generally thankful; it's another to *practice* being mindful.

Gratitude is not the **reward** for a good day; **mindfulness is the discipline that remakes a day**—and, over time, remakes us.

Why this matters for our community

When we practice gratitude together, we become a church that notices. We notice the people who are often unseen. We notice what God is already doing in small, quiet ways. We notice where healing has begun and where we're still longing for it. Gratitude doesn't deny pain or gloss over grief; it trains our eyes to find God's presence even there. That's the difference between being cured and being made well.

Imagine as our church becomes known as "the church that pays attention"—to God, to one another, to the needs of our neighbors. That kind of attention changes how we worship, how we serve, and how we talk to each other in meetings and hallways. It turns complaints into curiosities, impatience into intercession, and routine tasks into offerings.

With gratitude for each of you and those stones are still outside the sanctuary doors if you would like to grab a few for family and friends this November ©



Mission Investment Future4KIDZ

In 2005 Immanuel became a Mission Future 4KIDZ Congregation. All baptized children should have received \$50 from Immanuel Lutheran to start their Mission Future 4KIDZ investment in the ELCA Mission Investment Fund. There was a lapse in this offering and we are now offering this investment once again and retroactively to children baptized at Immanuel.

When a congregation makes this investment it does three things:

- It celebrates Baptism and makes it a lifelong event, since investment doesn't
 mature until the child is 18 years old. Each quarter they get a statement of
 funds growth which could be a reminder of this gift from our congregation.
- 2. The parents become the custodian of the account and they realize that the Body of Christ is larger than just the local congregation. They sense the larger church at work doing ministry.
- 3. The children become little stewards from the get go. They get excited about mission and ministry when they see the churches that their money is helping to build, plus they receive an interest rate on their own savings.

If parents choose to accept our gift for their child, they will need to complete an application form and return it to the church. Immanuel will in turn send it to Mission Investment with our \$50 gift to start the investment for the child. The parents will then become the custodian of and manage the account until it matures on the child's 18th birthday. They will be sent a booklet with deposit coupons that can be used by family members & friends to make additions at any time to celebrate important events in the child's life such as graduation, birthdays or Christmas gifts. A great way to set aside money for college or other needs. The MIF will send a birthday card and a Christmas card to the child each year, and will also send cards, on request, to notify parents when funds have been added to the child's investment.

Immanuel Lutheran's members hope this investment will serve as a constant reminder to the child of the their baptism and as an effective way to save for their future.

For those children baptized during the lapse, a letter, along with a MIF4KIDZ brochure and an application form will be sent to the parents offering this investment for their child. If they choose to accept this gift, they will be asked to return the application form to church before January 1, 2026.

If you had a child baptized at Immanuel during the lapse, and did not receive a letter, please let the church know.
