The wearing of jewellery by children can present a potential hazard, in that it can easily get caught in equipment and clothing and cause choking and tearing injuries.

We do require you to provide Plasters/Micro pore tape to enable us to cover your child's earrings during the day, during sleep times and also whilst in the outdoor areas to reduce the risk of accidents and any injuries.

Should you choose to allow your child to wear earrings in nursery, we will require parents/carers to sign and return the attached form.
