What is CGS?

Established in 1998

CGS provides gifted and highly motivated high school students a challenging, differentiated, and interdisciplinary academic program of study in the core subject areas of English, mathematics, science, and social studies using non-traditional activities supported by technology at their sites.

Who Should Apply?



Gifted or high-achieving students **AND** highly motivated learners

Application starts with current 8th graders

Current 9th-10th graders may apply for open seats in specific grade level

Must successfully complete **Algebra I** by the end of the spring of 8th grade to be eligible to apply

For the rising 9th grade class, an average of **5 students are accepted** from the 8th grade class at Caroline.

What Makes CGS Unique?

Half-day program - Students spend a half-day in CGS courses and a half-day in their home school

Regional collaboration with common instructional planning

Instructional broadcasts across all sites by expert teachers

Field experiences in each content area

Purposeful course alignment to allow for **cross-curricular instruction**

Focus on **research and writing** through four-year culminating experience


