## SIGNING DAY & PARENT MEETING

Friday May 29<sup>th</sup> 7:00 - 9:00 PM

Celebrate a new season on signing day! There will be a parent meeting along with information and activities from the Omega Support Squad.

## PRACTICES

Practices will be twice weekly, for 2 hours each. The months of June and July, both practices will be scheduled for evenings during the week. August through the end of the season, each team will have one practice on Sundays and one practice another evening during the week. **These days and times will be announced at the team reveal in May.**

Mandatory practices listed above are MANDATORY for all athletes.

The week of April 4<sup>th</sup> - April 10<sup>th</sup> teams will have additional practices added as teams get ready for All Star World Championship (ASW). Please keep evenings free.

Practices in Florida for (ASW) will be posted in SportsYou. Please plan travel accordingly.

## RED ZONE

Practices are mandatory 2 weeks before a competition. If you miss practice within this timespan, you may not compete at the next competition. It will be at the coaches' discretion.

All absences within 2 weeks of a performance are considered unexcused and you will be charged \$50 for each practice that is missed. Fines can be excused in the event of an emergency, illness (vomiting/fever), significant family event such as a funeral, or unsafe road conditions as reported by INDOT.

# TUITION & BILLING

The full-season team will have eleven (11) installments of \$450.00 billed monthly between June 2026 to April 2027 (base cost \$4,950). If full uniform and bow are needed, monthly installments are \$515.00 (base cost \$5,665).

Our base cost is the total of all eleven (11) installments and the base cost must be covered regardless of when an athlete joins the program.

Individual uniform items can be ordered and paid in full or added into the monthly tuition.

Your base cost paid via monthly installment includes:

- Practice wear
- Competition Fees for nine (9) season competitions (7 weekends)
- Coaches' Fees for seven (9) season competitions (7 weekends)
- Team tuition
- Tumbling class tuition
- Choreography and music expenses

Expenses not included (*not an exhaustive list*):

- Gym's annual registration fee (*\$45 every 12 months of enrollment*)
- USASF membership (*\$49 yearly June 1st 2026 - May 31st 2027*)
- Warm-ups (*Not required but will be offered in our team store*)
- Makeup
- Travel expenses
- Cheer bag (*No specific kind of bag is required*)
- White cheer shoes (*No specific brand is required*)
- End of Season Event costs (*to be billed separately*)

Tuition is due on the 8<sup>th</sup> of each month.

Practice wear or uniform pieces will not be handed out to athletes if there is an overdue balance on their account.

All athletes must have a card on file and will be signed up automatically for autopay via iClassPro to avoid unnecessary fees and penalties. If your payment method is declined, a \$25.00 returned payment fee will be accessed.

## Discounts

You may pay your base cost in full if desired by June 8<sup>th</sup> for a 10% discount if paid in cash or check and 5% if paid with card. Siblings receive a 15% discount off their monthly installment.

**No refunds are provided** including anyone who voluntarily leaves the program, is dismissed from the program, or has an injury.

## Penalty

A penalty of \$500 (per team) will be charged to the individual athlete in the event that the athlete quits on or after the date of the first choreography practice. This fee will be waived if leaving due to a season ending injury with medical note

## **Crossover & Alternates**

Crossovers do not pay additional tuition; however, crossovers will have additional competition fees. These fees will be charged in addition to monthly tuition.

Alternates will not have fees *if* they are placed on another team. If the athlete does not have a placement on another team in the program, they will be charged a discounted monthly tuition rate based on their limited participation.

## **UNIFORMS**

Uniforms worn during the 2025-2026 season will be worn during the 2026-2027 season. The bow will also remain the same.

There is a Buy/Sell group to sell and purchase used uniform items or parents will have the option to order new pieces if needed. SportsYou code for the Buy/Sell group: BPT8-YZEA

## **TUMBLING**

All star athletes have a tumbling class at Omega Elite included as part of their tuition. There is no discount if you do not choose to utilize this class. You may register your athlete for any available tumbling class that works with your schedule and is the appropriate level for their skill set. Please register by contacting the front desk or emailing [info@omegaelite.com](mailto:info@omegaelite.com) with your enrollment request (provide their name, the team they are on, and the specific class you wish them to be enrolled in).

If they are already enrolled in a tumbling class, this credit will be applied to the class in which they are already enrolled. This benefit is only available for one class at a time, and additional classes will be charged at normal tuition rates.

The free tumbling class is valid until April 30th even if the season is over prior to that point. Enrollment will continue for normal tuition rates following that date. If you wish to unenroll from the tumbling class, request a drop through the customer portal thirty days in advance of the desired drop date (prior to April 1st if you do not wish to be charged).

Transfers, drops, and reporting absences for your tumbling class can be handled through the customer portal. If athletes are absent for more than two weeks in a row, they may be removed from their tumbling class and will need to re-enroll to resume participation.

## **TRAVEL**

Each athlete is responsible for their way to and from each competition. The price of admission, travel, gas, hotels, or other expenses are the responsibility of the individual. Omega Elite is not responsible for

any accidents while traveling to and from events.

## END OF SEASON

End of Season costs (competition fees, coaches fees, and potential choreography and/or music expenses) will be billed in addition to your monthly installments. Usually these expenses are billed in March and April but dates and amounts will be communicated on SportsYou once they are known.

## SUPPORT SQUAD

To help supplement athlete tuition, there is a Booster Club run by athlete parents that offers multiple fundraising opportunities throughout the year. Omega Support Squad is a non-profit, registered 501c3 entity separate from Omega Elite. Fundraisers using the program's name, branding, or resources are required to be approved by gym leadership or the Support Squad.
