Overview

The Novice Cheer Program at Omega Elite is for beginner and developing athletes that want to be introduced to all star cheerleading or are still developing the fundamentals before pursuing a more competitive training program. There is a Fall and Spring session each season. Your child can choose to participate in both sessions or only one. A new routine is learned in each session. This program requires the lowest amount of commitment both financially and in time.

Please note that depending on number of athletes and ages we may choose to divide the program into multiple teams to create a better learning environment and your unique team may not be called Triton.

Practices

- Mondays 6:00 PM – 7:30 PM
- Starts January 12th
- Choreography will be worked into practices
- Attendance is important for these athletes as they have limited time to prepare for competition – *please be confident you can commit.*

Competitions

- Competing Open Scorecard
- Novice Division
 - 1.5 minute routine
 - Teams are not ranked against each other, but receive a rating based on their score
 - Restrictions on building and tumbling
- One-day competitions

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Tuition & Billing

The Novice program will have four (4) installments of \$150.00 billed monthly for the first session of participation. The price is reduced to \$115.00 billed monthly for the second session of participation in a season.

Fall Session: September – December

Spring Session: January - April

Your monthly installment includes:

- Uniform
- Bow
- Competition Fees for session competition
- Coaches' Fees for session competition
- Team tuition
- Choreography and music expenses

Expenses not included (*not an exhaustive list*):

- Annual registration fee
- USASF membership
- Warm-ups (*Not required but will be offered in our team store*)
- Makeup
- Cheer shoes (*No specific brand is required - shoes must be white*)
- Travel expenses
- Cheer bag (*No specific kind of bag is required*)
- Tumbling

Monthly payments are charged on the 1st of the month and due by the 8th. Autopay runs on the 8th.

Our base cost is the total of all four (4) installments and the base cost must be covered regardless of when an athlete joins the program.

You may pay your base cost in full if desired. Siblings receive a 15% discount off their monthly installment.

No refunds are provided to anyone who voluntarily leaves the program or is dismissed from the program.

A penalty of \$500 (per team) will be charged to the individual athlete in the event that the athlete quits on or after the fifth held practice. This fee will be waived if leaving due to a season ending injury with medical note.
